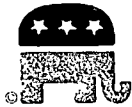

Dear Mr. President:

It was great to hear from you today, as usual. It means a great deal to me for you to take the time to call.

Now that you have a budget compromise that you are happy with, and looks to me like it makes sense, perhaps it's time to shift the agenda. Your great strength is personal diplomacy as it has related to the Persian Gulf and world affairs.

This strength has been largely responsible for your higher than average job-approval rating. Why not try to get back to that now and shift the agenda. Be seen meeting with and talking to world leaders. I truly believe this effort would be the greatest use of your time between now and election day. It would help us with the Party, with candidates, and with the general public, and I see no downside even if you don't sweep candidates into office.

By dealing from your biggest strength, every time you, George Bush, are seen dealing with a world leader, you are winning, regardless of how much it is helping other candidates. I would urge you to get on that phone and be seen many times a day with Middle Eastern and world leaders talking about meaningful peace.

There are millions of people out there still scared. When they see the leader of their country in action, it only helps, and from a political standpoint, regardless of what you are doing with voters, you are still on the offense -- and you are much better on the offense than on the defense.

Please take this in a positive manner from one of the longest-time Bush observers in the country.

POOL REPORT # 8

BUSH GOES GOLFING

HONOLULU, HAWAII

OCTOBER 28, 1990

First, a bit of news. Bush said he will sign the Foreign Operations bill despite cuts in El Salvador aid. The bill also includes the Egyptian debt forgiveness. "I will sign the Foreign Ops," he said. Asked if he was concerned about the El Salvador cuts he said, "Yes, we're very much concerned about it."

He would not respond to other questions from your pool.

Bush played at Hickam Air Force Base. The group included: Admiral Huntington Hardisty, CINCPAC; Prime Minister Ratu Sir Kamisese Mara of Fiji; Prime Minister Geoffrey Arama Henry of the Cook Islands; and Brent Scowcroft. They played in two threesomes and finished in about 2 hours 18 minutes. About an hour into the round, there was a small shower of no consequence.

After Bush finished his round, he engaged in a putting contest with Admiral Hardisty and Prime Minister Henry as they awaited the other threesome. He said he would be sorry to leave the island. When he was told that everyone was ready to leave, he held up his hand and said, "Watch and learn," as he then lined up a putt. He promptly pulled it to the left and missed it.

Motorcades were uneventful.
