

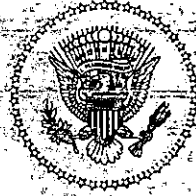

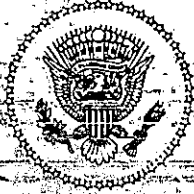

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

FROM MAJOR SEAN BYRNE *Sean*

SUBJECT: Phone Call From Secretary Baker (24 November, 1990)

Secretary Baker returned your call last night and requested I pass the following information to you:

1) He concluded his meeting with the Malaysians and was preparing to depart Los Angeles enroute Houston, scheduled to arrive at approximately 2:00 a.m. Sunday morning. He will be there until Monday afternoon when he returns to Washington DC.

2) After his discussion with you and all of the members of the Security Council, except Cuba, he is calling for a Security Council meeting for this Thursday. His staff was working on a release announcing the meeting.

3) The meeting with Colombia went well. The Malaysian meeting was tougher because they have greater problems. He did not elaborate on this point.

4) Although he has been tied up much of the last few days, what he has seen of your visits to Egypt and Geneva has been very favorable.

5) He will call you Sunday, probably late morning or early afternoon local time.


