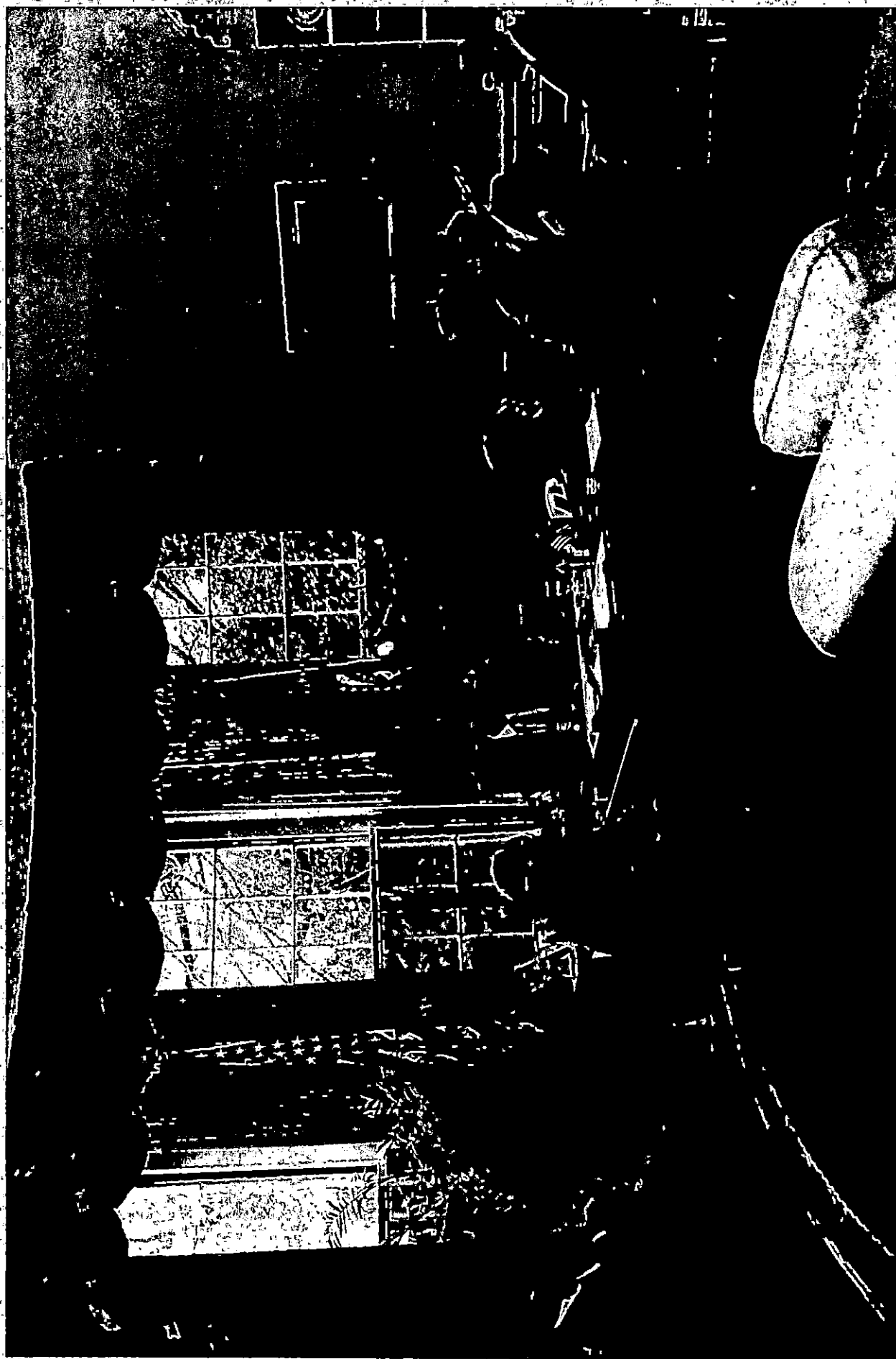

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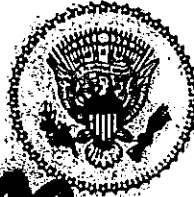

SUBJECT: DAVID FROST INTERVIEW

> Your interview with David Frost is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on Sunday, December 16. It will be broadcast January 2 on PBS. The format will be very similar to that of past years with approximately one hour of one-on-one with you and David, followed by 20 minutes with you and Mrs. Bush together. In addition, David will also spend approximately 20 minutes one-on-one with Mrs. Bush.

David is looking to replicate the same casual, conversational, reflective interviews of the past two years with a focus on your first two years in office. He wants to discuss what you have accomplished midway through your first term and what's ahead.

The one-on-one segment will be in the Oval Office, and the other two segments in the Roosevelt Room.
