Military Coup in Suriname

Acting Armed Forces Commander Ivan Graanoogst announced the military overthrew President Ramsewak Shankar in a coup last night at 2230 local. The national television station had been taken over by the military several hours earlier. Graanoogst stated a new government will be installed next week and free elections held within the next 100 days. There have been no reports of shooting and Shankar's whereabouts are unknown.

The coup apparently was sparked by Saturday's resignation of Colonel Desire Bouterse as armed forces commander. Bouterse quit after President Shankar failed to protest Bouterse's detention by Dutch police earlier this month. A military government led by Bouterse ruled Suriname from 1980-1987. Shankar was elected president by the national assembly in January 1988.
