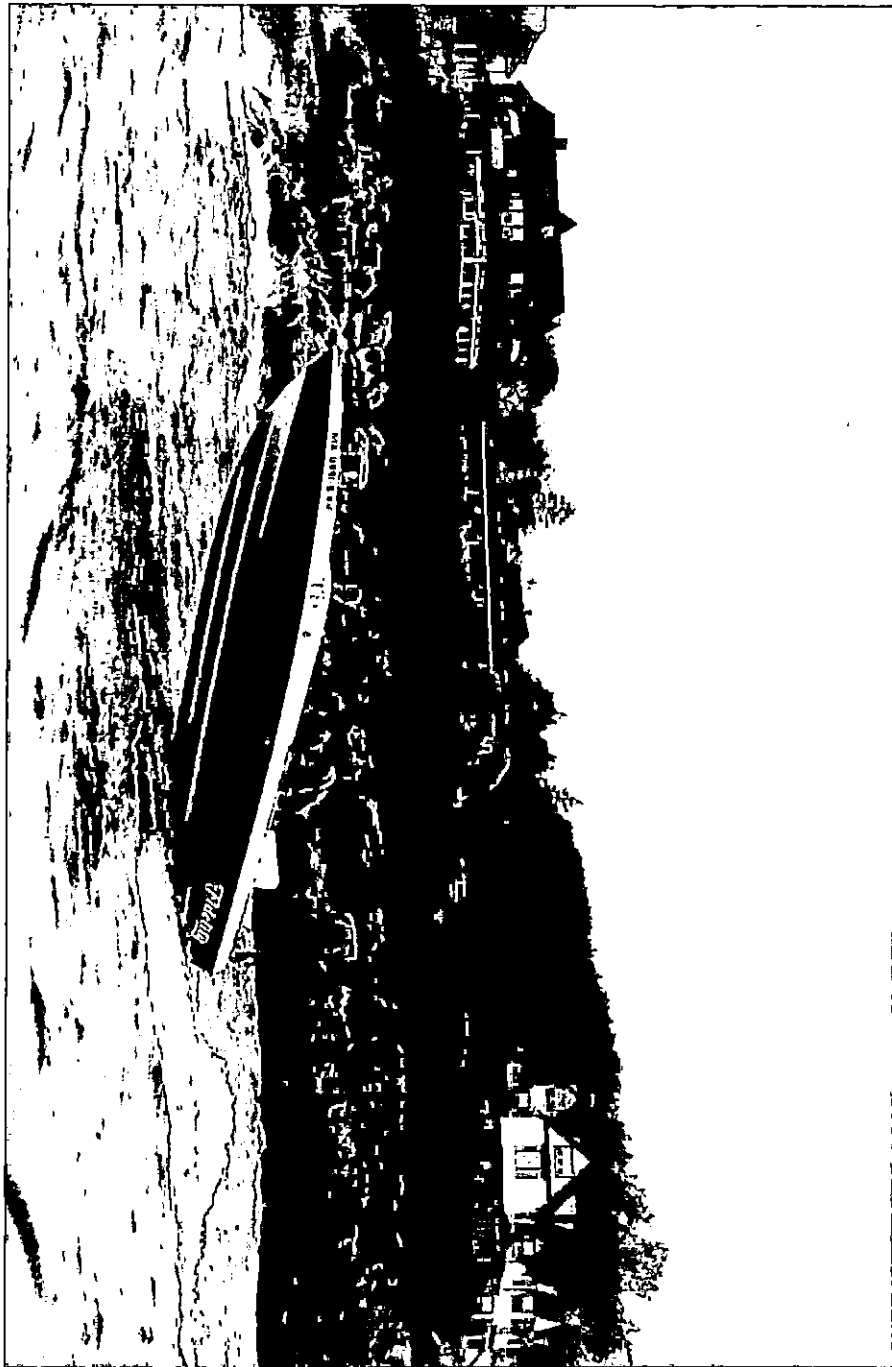

BUSH GOES TO VESTRY BREAKFAST AND TO CHURCH

KENNEBUNKPORT, MAINE

SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 1991

The President left fog-shrouded Walker's Point at around 8:47 this morning to attend a 9:00 a.m. breakfast meeting of the St. Ann's Episcopal Church Vestry in the parsonage adjacent to the church. The breakfast, at which Bush delivered brief remarks, lasted about 45 minutes, after which the President and other members of the vestry came out on the stairs for a class photo.

Bush then answered questions from the pool on the hostages, the House Republican intelligence report that says terrorism is still a danger in the Middle East, and the continuing parade of protestors coming to Kennebunkport. A transcript of the remarks will be prepared by the White House Press Office.

The theme of the church service, which began at 10:00 a.m., was spiritual renewal, highlighted by the baptism of nearly four-month-old Natalie Lane Marshman (phonetic spelling), who was born April 25. Bush participated in the baptism ceremony by reading some of the prayers to which the congregation responded.

The Rev. John Allin, Sr. conducted the services, and during the "Children's Time" led the group in the singing of the old Negro spiritual, "Down By the Riverside," which featured the line "Ain't gonna' study war no more."

When the Bushes emerged from church at around 10:45, they were greeted by the applause of tourists gathered behind the rope across the church drive. Motorcade back was routine.

Fashion note: The President did not wear white socks or shoes this week, as he did last, choosing instead dark brown shoes, gray suit, cream-colored shirt and navy-dotted tie. Mrs. Bush wore an orchid suit, purple shoes, a triple-strand of white beads and matching white earrings. Her stockings also appeared to have an orchid hue.

Mrs. Dorothy Walker Bush, son George W. and several grandchildren also attended.

The President planned to go boating on choppy seas after church, much to the consternation of some Secret Service agents who expressed concern for their stomachs. A satellite-link speech to the National Governors' Association meeting in Seattle is scheduled for 4:00 p.m. The speech will last about 20 minutes and will be piped into the filing center. A transcript will follow.

No other activities away from Walker's Point are expected today.
