Bush would not answer a question about Baltic independence, muttering something a press conference "every five minutes."

Also spotted on the course were First Lady Barbara Bush and daughter Doro.

Bush and Heminway wore nearly identical tan slacks and sea green sport shirts.

Bush-Baker Press Conference

Press conference held outside the President's office at Walker's Point. President dressed in blue jeans, and a tan, western shirt. Baker wore sport coat and tie and cream colored trousers.

Marlin Fitzwater said Baker arrived about noon and joined Bush and several domestic advisers in watching Gorbachev's press conference while they ate lunch in the living room at Walker's Point. Domestic team included Sununu, Darman, Porter, Card and Teeter. The domestic advisers stood to the side of Bush and Baker as they held their press conference.

Marlin said Baker would be leaving immediately after his meeting with Bush for Wyoming to resume his vacation.

After the Press Conference Baker walked over to hug Nancy Bush Ellis, the President's sister, and the President asked her in vain to pose for pictures. "How do you think your brother is doing?" Bush asked her. She did not respond.

Marlin said during the Yeltsin call to Bush Wednesday night, Yeltsin told Bush he had been up for about 48 hours and wanted to report that "events were under control."

In other news, Marlin said he might not brief on Friday, depending on whether he has anything to say. He said that for the Mulroney and Major visits, the press would see the leaders three times each: Arrival, press conference, and departure.
