SUBJECT: WEEKEND SCHEDULE

10:00 p.m. (approx.) Colu Bush and Lucilla Schmitz arrive the White House (overnight)

11:00 a.m. Special Tour for 9 members of the Ballet Folklorico DeMexico.

(They will be on the South Lawn for the arrival of the President and Mrs. Bush when they return at 11:45 a.m. Also present will be your Senior Class from Phillips Andover -- they are in town for a reunion. Debbie Romash of the Visitors office will coordinate w/ Wayne Justice so that you will know where they are standing so you can say hello.)

11:45 a.m. The President and Mrs. Bush return by helicopter to the South Lawn of the White House.

12:00 noon The President joins Marvin Bush at the White House tennis court.

(to be determined) Mrs. Carlos Salinas arrives the White House (She may be accompanied by her daughter or her sister.)

2:45 p.m. The President, Mrs. Bush, Columba Bush, Lucilla Schmitz and Mrs. Carlos Salinas depart the White House enroute the Lisner for Ballet Folklorico DeMexico. (DETAILED SCHEDULE TO FOLLOW) (2 hour performance - 1 intermission)

5:15 p.m. The President, Mrs. Bush, Columba Bush, Lucilla Schmitz, and Mrs. Salinas return to the White House. All overnight.

Mrs. Bush,

I wanted to let you know of a remarkable incident that took place here last night. At 6:35 p.m. I received a call from the uniformed sergeant at the Northwest gate. He said that the Prime Minister of Latvia had just pulled up in his motorcade with a full detail of US Secret Service Agents. They were asking if it would be possible to step inside the gate to take a few photo's of the White House. I saw no harm in this so I said yes. A minute later the entire group walked up to the North Portico. I walked out and met the Prime Minister, his assistant, and I believe his deputy, plus one other person. I offered to give them a tour and they graciously accepted. I showed them the State Floor which they appreciated very much. They thanked me over and over, then left. The entire episode lasted less than 15 minutes.

I thought you should be informed of this, you just never know who might show up around here!

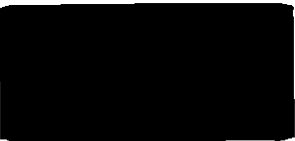

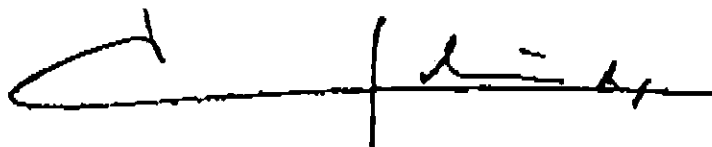
Estimado George:
