PURPOSE: To urge Senators Sanford and Bryan to vote for Bob Clarke, your nominee to be Comptroller of the Currency, at tomorrow's meeting of the Senate Banking Committee.

BACKGROUND:

On January 23, 1991, you nominated Bob Clarke to continue to serve as the chief regulator for 4,000 national banks. His confirmation has been strongly opposed by Banking Committee Chairman Don Riegle (D-MI).

- Bob's record shows that he increased bank supervision, alerted banks to risky activities, worked with banks to restore them to health, and strengthened bank management.
- He has worked hard to address the problems of the "credit crunch."
