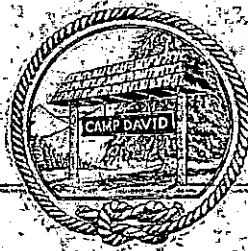

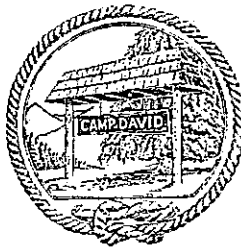

SUBJECT: Intellectual Property Negotiations

Attached is a memorandum from Ambassador Hills describing the status of section 301 negotiations with China and India regarding intellectual property rights. All EPC agencies concur with these actions.

China

While negotiations are continuing, USTR believes that the progress thus far is insufficient to justify postponing trade sanctions. Accordingly, USTR has announced its intent to publish a section 301 retaliation list tomorrow. The objective of publishing a list would be to pressure the Chinese to resolve the key remaining issues. The sanctions would not take effect for at least 30 days.

India

Negotiations are being extended for up to three months in light of promising assurances provided by India.

Subject: Extension of Intellectual Property Protection
Investigations of China and India

On May 26, 1991, pursuant to your direction, we initiated "Special 301" investigations of Indian and Chinese intellectual property laws and practices. Both countries have major deficiencies in their copyright, patent, and other intellectual property laws, and have been the subject of strenuous complaints from our movie, computer software, and pharmaceutical industries.

The trade law states that the investigations and accompanying negotiations shall be concluded within six months, which ends today. The law permits an extension of the negotiations for up to an additional three months in complex cases.

Today's Announcement

With the concurrence of all EPC agencies, we are announcing at 5:00 pm today an extension of the negotiations in both cases. More specifically:

With respect to India, we are extending the talks for up to three months. The Indian government has provided us specific written assurances on several major issues (although we have agreed to keep their letter confidential at this time) and has promised to work in good faith to resolve the remaining problems.

With respect to China, recent negotiations have produced progress, but we have not yet been able to reach the minimum agreement that both Jim Baker and I warned the PRC would be necessary to avert our taking a public step toward retaliation. Therefore, unless there is a breakthrough today, we will publish tomorrow for public comment a list of products from China that could be chosen for punitive tariffs if the case is not resolved. We could move to actual retaliation after the close of the public comment period (i.e., no earlier than December 27).

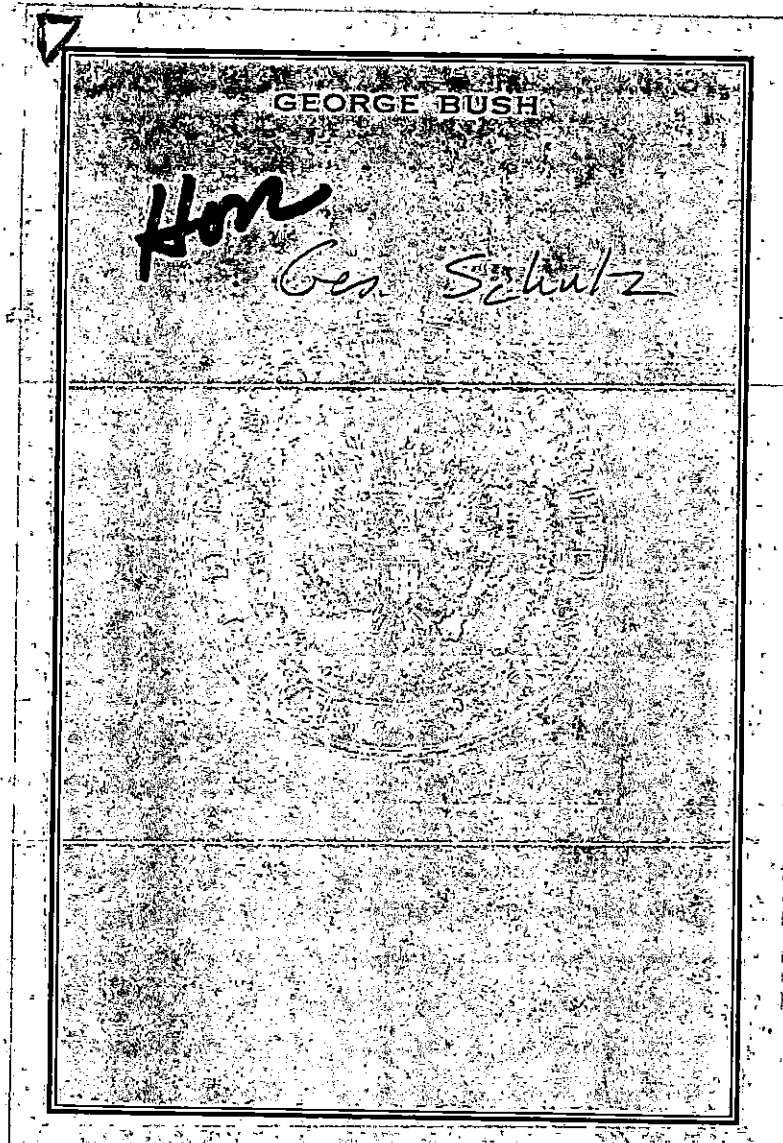
We believe that the publication of a potential retaliation list will prod the Chinese to close on the major outstanding issues, and help bolster Congressional support for retention of China's MFN status.

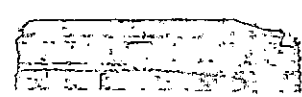
