THE PEOPLE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE KNOW THE WAY THE WORLD WORKS. THEY KNOW THAT OUR ECONOMIC LEADERSHIP ABROAD ENSURES OUR ECONOMIC SUCCESS AT HOME. IT MEANS MARKETS FOR AMERICAN PRODUCTS AND JOBS FOR AMERICAN WORKERS. IT MAKES ROOM TO SPREAD OUR WINGS TO SHOW THE WORLD WHAT WE CAN DO. THE AMERICA I KNOW IS AN EAGLE, NOT AN OSTRICH.

AND TO LEAD ABROAD, WE'VE GOT TO GET A FEW THINGS STRAIGHT AT HOME -- LIKE FIRST PRINCIPLES. AND OUR FIRST PRINCIPLE IS THIS: GOVERNMENT IS TOO BIG AND IT COSTS TOO MUCH.

BELIEVE IT OR NOT, SOME PEOPLE STILL DON'T GET IT. SOME OF THEM HAVE EVEN COME UP HERE TO NEW HAMPSHIRE -- FOR A FEW WEEKS, ANYWAY. YOU KNOW HOW IT IS: THEY COME AND THEY GO.

SO NEXT TUESDAY, I'M ASKING YOU, NEIGHBOR TO NEIGHBOR, TO SEND THEM A MESSAGE THEY CAN TAKE WITH THEM: GOVERNMENT IS STILL TOO BIG, AND IT STILL COSTS TOO MUCH, AND IF YOU STILL DON'T GET IT, GET OUT OF THE WAY.

AND ASK THEM: WHO SHOULD CHOOSE A CHILD'S SCHOOL -- PARENTS OR THE GOVERNMENT? I SAY: THE PARENTS -- BECAUSE AS LONG AS I'M PRESIDENT, FAMILIES COME FIRST IN AMERICA.

THE DECISION WE MAKE THIS YEAR WILL DETERMINE HOW THOSE QUESTIONS ARE ANSWERED: THEIR WAY -- OR OUR WAY.

YOUR VOTE WILL DECIDE WHAT KIND OF SCHOOLS YOUR CHILDREN WILL GO TO -- WHAT KIND OF MEDICAL CARE YOUR FAMILY WILL GET -- WHAT KIND OF JOB YOU'LL HAVE, AND WHAT KIND YOUR CHILDREN WILL HAVE WHEN THEY START FAMILIES OF THEIR OWN.

NEW HAMPSHIRE'S PRINCIPLE IS RIGHT: LIMIT GOVERNMENT, NOT FREEDOM.

IF WE STICK TO THAT PRINCIPLE, WE HAVE NO REASON TO FEAR THE FUTURE. LAST MONTH I SENT CONGRESS A PLAN TO CLEAR AWAY THE OBSTACLES GOVERNMENT PLACES IN THE PATH TO ECONOMIC GROWTH -- SEVEN STEPS TO SPUR INVESTMENT AND CREATE JOBS.

MY PLAN WOULD BRING THE DREAM OF HOMEOWNERSHIP TO YOUNG FAMILIES THAT CAN'T QUITE AFFORD IT. IT WOULD BOOST REAL ESTATE VALUES -- BECAUSE I WANT TO MAKE SURE THAT WHEN YOU OWN A HOME, ITS VALUE GOES UP, NOT DOWN.

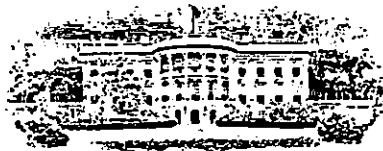

Dear President Bush:

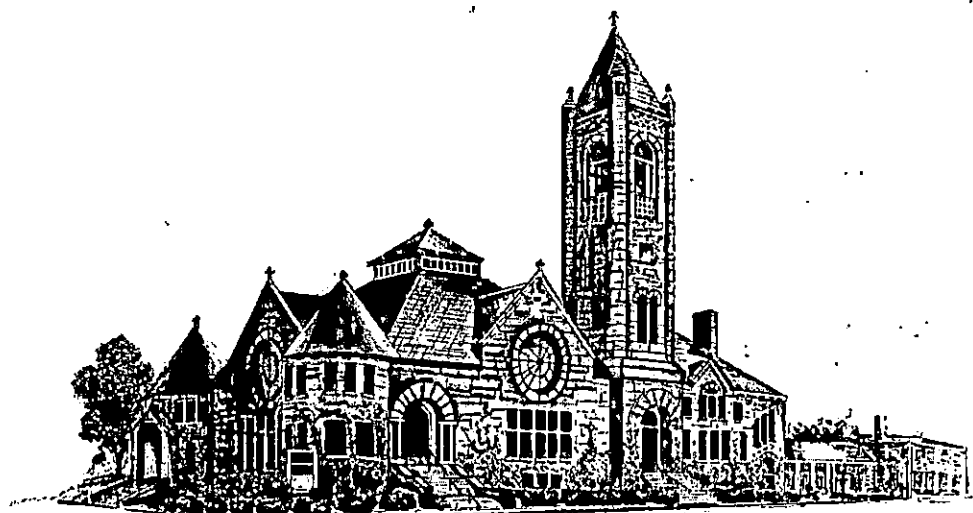

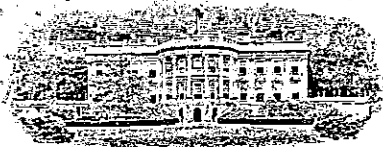

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POOL REPORT # 6

Pancake Breakfast and Church

February 16, 1992

While the folks in the gymnasium awaited the President, he shook hands and ate breakfast with a group of about 100 in what appeared to be a school cafeteria.

Your pool observed the following: the President approaching the place set for him (plastic fork, plastic plate, pitcher of syrup, pancakes and bacon) saying something about tackling the "chow here." Within minutes, his plate was clean, but he spent about 10 minutes at the table. He scarfed down the pancakes on which he had put a restrained amount of syrup, sometimes lowering his face to within a foot of the plate for particularly large chunks of food. The bacon he managed with his fingers. It was impossible to determine whether the constant flow of conversation he kept up with his neighbors slowed the process.

He sat between 9 year old Matt Challer of Keene and Nancy Woods, who appeared to be in her 30's, of Nashua.

Before sitting down, the President spent about 15 minutes walking between the tables, shaking hands and shopping. One gentleman who celebrated his 81st birthday yesterday was given a Presidential tie clip taken off the Presidential tie.

Apart from the spinning that Skinner performed, and is presumably in the earlier pool report, the Chief of Staff made the following points to the pool while the President worked the crowd. The themes of the day, he said, would be "Family, religion, church, New Hampshire, and Bush. There all equal." In reference to the President's quick mention yesterday of the phrase, "Stay the course" Skinner said "You've got to stay the course sometimes." Asked if the President had any attack ads in the can, he said "If they are in the can, they're going to stay in the can." He explained he meant in the garbage can. He would not say much about Buchanan's numbers but said "This is a very special state," one that has a tradition of giving insurgent candidates a substantial vote. He said the Bush team had never thought Buchanan's vote wouldn't reach at least into the 30's range.

The church the President attended was the first church, a Congregational-United Church of Christ congregation in Nashua. There were the normal children's choirs for which Bush leaned forward in his pew at the front. The building was constructed in 1894 when Hugh Gregg's grandfather was pastor. The service lasted 1 hour and 10 minutes. During the 25 minute sermon by the Reverend James S. Chaloner, Bush was either concentrating so hard that his eyes were closed, deep in meditation, or asleep. In any case, your pool observed him on occasion with his eyes closed. Among the readings were the following biblical lines: "Love your enemies, woe to you who are rich. You have received your consolation. Woe to you who are full. You will be hungry." The sermon was entitled "What in the world is God doing?" See your pooler if you want more details. Only a brief reference to the President's presence in the church was made during the morning. Later, Bush visited with the children's sunday school class. One child said to the President and Mrs. Bush "You two have a big house." Again, any questions see your pooler.

Pool Report -- Bush at pancake breakfast, Pennichuck Jr. High

While Bush ate, Skinner accused Buchanan of negative politics ~~xxxxxx~~, saying that his charge that Bush has abandoned the middle class is desperation politics. "One reason Pat Buchanan raised this issue and mistated the record...is out of desperation. There's no ~~xxxxxx~~ other excuse for it. And you saw the president was upset about that yesterday."

"For someone to come up and say you've abandoned the middle class -- when the same day we ~~xx~~ submitted the short-term package we submitted the long-term package and asked for action ~~xx~~ this year on both -- that's election-year politics."

Asked why the \$500 child tax credit increase was not included in short-term recovery package, Skinner said: "Because it really doesn't do anything to stimulate the economy." Referring to Tsongas, he said: "Even the man who's going to win the Democratic nomination doesn't think it's a good idea" ~~xxxxxx~~

Skinner again pointed out that the tax credit was never meant to be included in the short term package, which he said was designed to give an immediate "shock" to the economy. Was always part of Bush's broader budget proposal, which he said hasn't been reported ~~xxxxxx~~ accurately by press.

He also offered spin on the primary outcome, saying he's worried that the press ~~W~~will not focus on what New Hampshire traditionally has done in primary elections and misstate or misunderstand what that's all about." He reminded us that incumbent presidents have never won by big margins here. Cited Nixon and Ford and even Reagan as examples.

Asked if Bush is running scared, Skinner replied: "I think we'll do well...But this is New Hampshire and New Hampshire has a record of talking practically. Some voters in New Hampshire vote opposite (the incumbent). "We're gonna win...by at least one (percentage point)," he stressed. "Somewhere between one and 40 points."

He said he hopes the press will be "fair" with its coverage and make not of the above points.

Said New Hampshire is a "retail politics state."

"It's one of the few states in the ~~xxxxxx~~ nation where you can really get out and meet people and see people...So, you do retail politicking here and he loves it and he's very good at it."

Skinner also ~~xxxxxx~~ stressed that the Bush campaign is not being run on "fluctuations in the polls," saying that would not be ~~xxx~~ "good logic."

Bush had breakfast with about 100 or so folk in a small hall off the big gym where he delivered his remarks. Couldn't hear much of what was said, but he posed for pictures, signed autographs, and gazed upon the flushed faces of several babies shoved under his nose by loving parents.

It appeared to be a predominantly Bush crowd and the ~~xxxxxx~~ prez enjoyed himself. Spotting Ellen Warren of Knight-Ridder talking with some folk, he shouted: "Is she asking upbeat, cheerful questions?" He also noted a couple of times to no one in particular: "I'm starving."

He finally got to chow down on pancakes and bacon, taking a seat between David and Nancy Woods, a young Nashua couple, and Matt Challer, a boy of maybe 8 or 9. But before eating, ~~xxxxxx~~ he made a point of telling your pool that he'd come across five people in a row who are solid supporters. He had Torie Clarke bring over Vivian Barry, 78, a former state legislator, selectwoman and former restaurant owner who met "George and Barbara years ago" ~~x~~ when he was running for president. New Hampshire will stick with him, she said. "They know what they have now," she said. "And I think he's going to do well in New Hampshire...All in all, it's not bad what he's done."

However, in assessing Bush's political mistakes, Mrs. Barry said he should never have made that "no new taxes" pledge, which has given Buchanan an opening.

Kevin Milligan, a Lincoln-Mercury car salesman in Nashua, who introduced Bush to his 3-month-old daughter Katelyn (not once but twice), also praised the prez.

"This guy is doing a great job...The economy is starting to pick up," he said, noting that car sales on his lot are beginning to rise.

~~xx~~ Business is still tough, he said. "But this guy is doing a good job. Nobody could do better."
