DEAR BRIAN,

I WANTED YOU TO KNOW BEFORE IT IS PUBLICLY ANNOUNCED THAT
PRESIDENT GORBACHEV AND I WILL MEET ABOARD U.S. AND SOVIET NAVAL
VESSELS IN THE MEDITERRANEAN ON DECEMBER 2 AND 3 TO REVIEW THE
CURRENT INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENT AND TO DISCUSS U.S.-SOVIET
RELATIONS. AS YOU ARE AWARE, THERE WILL BE A FULL-SCALE SUMMIT
IN THE UNITED STATES DURING THE LATE SPRING OR EARLY SUMMER OF
NEXT YEAR. THAT IS SOME TIME DISTANT AND PRESIDENT GORBACHEV AND
I HAVE AGREED THAT AN EARLIER INFORMAL MEETING TO EXCHANGE VIEWS
AT THIS TIME OF RAPID AND HISTORIC CHANGE WOULD BE USEFUL.

I DO NOT INTEND A DETAILED NEGOTIATING SESSION DURING THESE
DECEMBER TALKS NOR DO I EXPECT THAT PRESIDENT GORBACHEV AND I
WILL CONCLUDE AGREEMENTS IN THE COURSE OF THIS MEETING ON ANY
ISSUES OF SIGNIFICANCE. WITH REGARD TO CFE, I WILL NATURALLY
EXPLAIN THE WEST'S CURRENT POSITION AND HEAR OUT ANY NEW IDEAS
PRESIDENT GORBACHEV MAY HAVE.

AS YOU KNOW, I HAVE NOT HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO MEET WITH PRESIDENT
GORBACHEV SINCE BECOMING PRESIDENT, AND ALTHOUGH WE HAVE WRITTEN
TO EACH OTHER OFTEN, I WANT AGAIN TO ESTABLISH PERSONAL CONTACT
WITH HIM. I HOPE TO GET A BETTER SENSE OF HOW HE VIEWS THE
DEMAND OF PERESTROIKA AND THE FUTURE COURSE OF EAST-WEST AND
U.S.-SOVIET RELATIONS. I, OF COURSE, LOOK FORWARD TO SHARING MY
IMPRESSIONS WITH YOU UPON MY RETURN.

LONDON DECLARATION
ON A
TRANSFORMED NORTH ATLANTIC ALLIANCE

-
ISSUED BY THE HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT PARTICIPATING
IN THE MEETING OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC COUNCIL IN LONDON,
JULY 5-6, 1990
-

1. THE NORTH ATLANTIC ALLIANCE HAS BEEN THE MOST SUCCESSFUL DEFENSIVE ALLIANCE IN HISTORY. NOW, EUROPE HAS ENTERED A NEW, MORE PROMISING ERA. CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE IS LIBERATING ITSELF. THE SOVIET UNION HAS EMBARKED ON THE LONG JOURNEY TOWARD A FREE SOCIETY. THE WALLS THAT ONCE CONFINED PEOPLE AND IDEAS ARE COLLAPSING. EUROPEANS ARE DETERMINING THEIR OWN DESTINY. THEY ARE CHOOSING FREEDOM. THEY ARE CHOOSING ECONOMIC LIBERTY. THEY ARE CHOOSING PEACE. AS A CONSEQUENCE, THIS ALLIANCE MUST AND WILL ADAPT.

-
2. AS OUR ALLIANCE ENTERS ITS FIFTH DECADE AND LOOKS AHEAD TO A NEW CENTURY, IT MUST CONTINUE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMMON DEFENSE. NO ONE CAN BE CERTAIN OF THE FUTURE. WE NEED TO KEEP STANDING TOGETHER, TO EXTEND THE LONG PEACE WE HAVE ENJOYED THESE PAST FOUR DECADES. YET OUR ALLIANCE MUST BE EVEN MORE AN AGENT OF CHANGE. IT CAN HELP BUILD THE STRUCTURES OF A MORE UNITED CONTINENT, SUPPORTING SECURITY AND STABILITY WITH THE STRENGTH OF OUR SHARED FAITH IN DEMOCRACY, THE RIGHTS OF THE INDIVIDUAL, AND THE PEACEFUL RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES.

3. WE RECOGNIZE THAT, IN THE NEW EUROPE, THE SECURITY OF EVERY STATE IS INSEPARABLY LINKED TO THE SECURITY OF ITS NEIGHBORS. NATO MUST BECOME AN INSTITUTION WHERE EUROPEANS,

CANADIANS, AND AMERICANS WORK TOGETHER NOT ONLY FOR THE COMMON DEFENSE, BUT TO BUILD NEW PARTNERSHIPS WITH ALL THE COUNTRIES OF EUROPE. THE ATLANTIC COMMUNITY MUST REACH OUT TO THE NATIONS OF THE EAST, WHO CONFRONTED US AS ADVERSARIES IN THE COLD WAR, AND EXTEND THE HAND OF FRIENDSHIP.

-
4. WE WILL REMAIN A DEFENSIVE ALLIANCE AND WILL CONTINUE TO DEFEND ALL THE TERRITORY OF ALL OF OUR MEMBERS. WE HAVE NO AGGRESSIVE INTENTIONS AND WE COMMIT OURSELVES IN ALL CIRCUMSTANCES TO THE PEACEFUL RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES. WE WILL NEVER IN ANY CASE BE THE FIRST TO USE FORCE. TODAY, WE CALL UPON THE MEMBER STATES OF THE WARSAW PACT TO MAKE A SIMILAR SOLEMN COMMITMENT TO NON-AGGRESSION.

-
5. IN THAT SPIRIT, AND TO REFLECT THE CHANGING POLITICAL ROLE OF THE ALLIANCE, WE TODAY INVITE THE PRESIDENT OF THE SOVIET UNION, MIKHAIL GORBACHEV, TO COME TO BRUSSELS AND ADDRESS THE NORTH ATLANTIC COUNCIL. WE TODAY ALSO INVITE THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE SOVIET UNION, POLAND, HUNGARY, CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BULGARIA, AND ROMANIA TO COME TO NATO, NOT JUST TO VISIT, BUT TO STAY. WE

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PROPOSE THAT THE USSR, AND THESE COUNTRIES OF EASTERN EUROPE, OPEN PERMANENT LIAISON MISSIONS WITH AMBASSADORS HERE AT NATO. ALTHOUGH THESE NATIONS ARE NOT MEMBERS OF OUR ALLIANCE, THIS STEP WILL BRING THEM CLOSER TO OUR THINKING AND DELIBERATIONS IN THIS HISTORIC PERIOD OF CHANGE SO THAT THEIR DIPLOMATS -- AND GENERALS -- CAN BE SURE THAT THEIR VOICES ARE HEARD.

6. OUR ALLIANCE SHOULD DO ITS SHARE TO OVERCOME THE LEGACY OF DECADES OF SUSPICION. TO FOLLOW ON THE GENEROUS SOVIET INVITATION TO NATO SECRETARY GENERAL MANFRED WOERNER TO VISIT MOSCOW AND MEET WITH SOVIET LEADERS, WE SUGGEST THAT NATO'S SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER FOR EUROPE, GENERAL JOHN GALVIN, ALSO GO TO MOSCOW, AND EAST EUROPEAN CAPITALS, TO DISCUSS OUR ALLIANCE'S COMMITMENT TO PEACE.

7. MILITARY LEADERS FROM THROUGHOUT EUROPE GATHERED EARLIER THIS YEAR IN VIENNA TO TALK ABOUT THEIR FORCES AND DOCTRINE. NATO OFFERS TO HOST ANOTHER SUCH MEETING THIS AUTUMN, TO PROMOTE COMMON UNDERSTANDING. WE WILL EXPAND AND INTENSIFY MILITARY-TO-MILITARY CONTACTS ACROSS EUROPE, ALONGSIDE POLITICAL DISCUSSIONS ON PROBLEMS LIKE THE CONVERSION OF MILITARY RESOURCES TO CIVILIAN USE. IN THESE WAYS, WE INTEND TO ESTABLISH AN ENTIRELY DIFFERENT QUALITY OF OPENNESS IN EUROPE, WHICH IS ALSO WHY WE WANT TO CONCLUDE AN AGREEMENT ON OPEN SKIES.

8. THE SUBSTANTIAL PRESENCE OF NORTH AMERICAN CONVENTIONAL AND U.S. NUCLEAR FORCES IN EUROPE DEMONSTRATES THE UNDERLYING POLITICAL COMPACT THAT BINDS NORTH AMERICA'S FATE TO EUROPE'S DEMOCRACIES. BUT, AS EUROPE CHANGES, WE MUST PROFOUNDLY ALTER THE WAY WE THINK ABOUT DEFENSE.

9. TO REDUCE OUR MILITARY REQUIREMENTS, SOUND ARMS CONTROL AGREEMENTS ARE ESSENTIAL. THAT IS WHY WE PUT THE HIGHEST PRIORITY ON COMPLETING THIS YEAR THE FIRST TREATY TO REDUCE AND LIMIT CONVENTIONAL ARMED FORCES IN EUROPE (CFE). THESE TALKS SHOULD REMAIN IN CONTINUOUS SESSION UNTIL THE WORK IS DONE. YET WE HOPE TO GO FURTHER. USING THE MANDATE ALREADY IN PLACE FOR CFE, NEW CONVENTIONAL ARMS CONTROL TALKS CAN BEGIN WITH THE SAME MEMBERSHIP, ONCE A CFE TREATY IS SIGNED.

10. WE WILL SEEK THROUGH NEW CONVENTIONAL ARMS CONTROL NEGOTIATIONS IN THE 1990S FURTHER FAR-REACHING REDUCTIONS OF THE OFFENSIVE CAPABILITY OF CONVENTIONAL ARMED FORCES IN EUROPE, SO AS TO PREVENT ANY NATION FROM MAINTAINING DISPROPORTIONATE MILITARY POWER ON THE CONTINENT. WE WILL MAKE PROVISIONS AS NEEDED FOR DIFFERENT REGIONS TO REDRESS DISPARITIES AND TO ENSURE THAT NO ONE'S SECURITY IS HARMED AT ANY STAGE. THIS IS AN AMBITIOUS AGENDA, BUT IT MATCHES OUR GOAL: ENDURING PEACE IN EUROPE.

11. AS SOVIET TROOPS LEAVE EASTERN EUROPE AND A TREATY LIMITING CONVENTIONAL ARMED FORCES IS IMPLEMENTED, THE ALLIANCE'S FORCE STRUCTURE AND STRATEGY WILL CHANGE FUNDAMENTALLY TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS:

- THE ALLIANCE WILL FIELD SMALLER AND RESTRUCTURED ACTIVE FORCES. THESE FORCES WILL BE HIGHLY MOBILE AND VERSATILE, ENHANCING THE ALLIED COMMAND EUROPE MOBILE FORCE AND THE NATO COMPOSITE FORCE, SO THAT ALLIED LEADERS WILL HAVE MAXIMUM FLEXIBILITY IN DECIDING HOW TO RESPOND TO A CRISIS.

-
- THE CURRENT STRUCTURE OF NATIONAL CORPS SECTORS IN NATO WILL BE REPLACED. NATO WILL RELY INCREASINGLY ON MULTINATIONAL CORPS MADE UP OF NATIONAL UNITS.
-
- TO REINFORCE OUR COMMITMENT TO A MULTINATIONAL, COLLECTIVE APPROACH TO OUR COMMON DEFENSE, FORCES WILL BE INTEGRATED INTO THESE MULTINATIONAL CORPS IN PEACETIME. THESE MULTINATIONAL CORPS WILL BE LED BY CORPS COMMANDERS DESIGNATED BY NATO WHO WILL REPORT, THROUGH THE CHAIN OF COMMAND, TO THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER, EUROPE (SACEUR) WHO IN TURN ANSWERS TO ALLIED POLITICAL LEADERS.
-
- NATO WILL SCALE BACK THE READINESS OF ITS ACTIVE UNITS, REDUCING TRAINING REQUIREMENTS AND THE NUMBER OF EXERCISES.
-
- THE ALLIANCE WILL RELY MORE HEAVILY ON THE ABILITY TO

RECREATE LARGER FORCES IF AND WHEN THEY MIGHT BE NEEDED.

12. OUR ALLIANCE SHOULD ALSO TRANSFORM THE SIZE AND MISSION OF ITS NUCLEAR DETERRENT FORCES. TO KEEP THE PEACE, THE ALLIANCE MUST MAINTAIN AN APPROPRIATE MIX OF NUCLEAR AND CONVENTIONAL FORCES, BASED IN EUROPE, AND KEPT UP TO DATE. BUT, AS A DEFENSIVE ALLIANCE, NATO HAS ALWAYS STRESSED THAT NONE OF ITS WEAPONS WILL EVER BE USED EXCEPT IN SELF-DEFENSE AND THAT WE SEEK THE LOWEST AND MOST STABLE LEVEL OF NUCLEAR FORCES NEEDED TO SECURE THE PREVENTION OF WAR. THE POLITICAL AND MILITARY CHANGES IN EUROPE, AND THE PROSPECT OF FURTHER CHANGES, NOW ALLOW US TO GO FURTHER.

13. WE HAVE CONCLUDED THAT, AS A RESULT OF THE NEW POLITICAL AND MILITARY CONDITIONS IN EUROPE, THERE WILL BE A SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCED ROLE FOR THEATER NUCLEAR SYSTEMS OF THE SHORTEST RANGE. WE HAVE DECIDED SPECIFICALLY THAT, ONCE NEGOTIATIONS BEGIN ON SHORT-RANGE NUCLEAR FORCES, THE ALLIANCE POSITION WILL BE TO ELIMINATE ALL ITS NUCLEAR ARTILLERY SHELLS FROM EUROPE BY THE TIME ALL SOVIET STATIONED FORCES IN EUROPE HAVE RETURNED HOME.

14. NEW NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE SOVIET UNION ON THE REDUCTION OF SHORT-RANGE NUCLEAR FORCES SHOULD BEGIN SHORTLY AFTER A CFE AGREEMENT IS SIGNED.

15. WE WILL DEVELOP AN ARMS CONTROL FRAMEWORK FOR THESE NEGOTIATIONS WHICH TAKES INTO ACCOUNT OUR REQUIREMENTS FOR FAR FEWER NUCLEAR WEAPONS, AND THE DIMINISHED NEED FOR THEATER NUCLEAR SYSTEMS OF THE SHORTEST RANGE.

16. FINALLY, WITH THE TOTAL WITHDRAWAL OF SOVIET STATIONED FORCES AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A CFE AGREEMENT, THE ALLIANCE CAN REDUCE ITS RELIANCE ON NUCLEAR WEAPONS. THIS WILL ENABLE US, IN THE TRANSFORMED EUROPE, TO ADOPT A NEW NATO STRATEGY MAKING ITS NUCLEAR FORCES TRULY WEAPONS OF LAST RESORT.

17. IN THE CONTEXT OF THESE REVISED PLANS FOR DEFENSE AND ARMS CONTROL, AND WITH THE ADVICE OF NATO MILITARY AUTHORITIES

AND ALL INTERESTED MEMBER STATES, NATO SHOULD PREPARE A NEW ALLIED MILITARY STRATEGY MOVING AWAY FROM 'FORWARD DEFENSE' TOWARDS A REDUCED FORWARD PRESENCE AND MODIFYING 'FLEXIBLE RESPONSE' TO REFLECT A REDUCED RELIANCE ON NUCLEAR WEAPONS. IN THAT CONNECTION THE ALLIANCE SHOULD ELABORATE NEW FORCE PLANS CONSISTENT WITH THE REVOLUTIONARY CHANGES IN EUROPE. NATO'S HIGH LEVEL TASK FORCE SHOULD FORMULATE A DETAILED POSITION FOR THE FOLLOW-ON CONVENTIONAL ARMS CONTROL TALKS. NATO SHOULD ALSO PROVIDE A FORUM FOR ALLIED CONSULTATION ON THE UPCOMING NEGOTIATIONS ON SHORT-RANGE NUCLEAR FORCES. ALL THESE NATO BODIES, WORKING IN COORDINATION WITH THE NORTH ATLANTIC COUNCIL, SHOULD REPORT THEIR CONCLUSIONS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN 1991 TO THE NEXT MEETING OF NATO HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT.

18. OF COURSE, OUR ALLIANCE IS NOT ALONE IN HELPING TO SHAPE THE EUROPE OF THE TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY. THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY IS ALSO A VITAL PART. THE CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION IN EUROPE (CSCE) SHOULD BECOME MORE PROMINENT IN EUROPE'S FUTURE, BRINGING TOGETHER THE COUNTRIES OF EUROPE AND NORTH AMERICA.

19. WE SUPPORT A CSCE SUMMIT LATER THIS YEAR IN PARIS WHICH WOULD INCLUDE THE SIGNATURE OF A CFE AGREEMENT AND WOULD SET NEW STANDARDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, AND PRESERVATION, OF FREE SOCIETIES. IT SHOULD ENDORSE:

- CSCE PRINCIPLES ON THE RIGHT TO FREE AND FAIR ELECTIONS;
- CSCE COMMITMENTS TO RESPECT AND UPHOLD THE RULE OF LAW; AND
- CSCE GUIDELINES FOR ENHANCING ECONOMIC COOPERATION, BASED ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF FREE AND COMPETITIVE MARKET ECONOMIES.

20. WE FURTHER PROPOSE THAT THE CSCE SUMMIT IN PARIS DECIDE HOW THE CSCE, AS AN INSTITUTION, CAN PROVIDE A FORUM FOR WIDER POLITICAL DIALOGUE IN A MORE UNITED EUROPE. WE RECOMMEND THAT CSCE GOVERNMENTS ESTABLISH:

- A PROGRAM FOR REGULAR CONSULTATIONS AMONG MEMBER GOVERNMENTS AT THE MINISTERIAL LEVEL, AT LEAST ONCE EACH YEAR, WITH OTHER PERIODIC MEETINGS OF OFFICIALS TO PREPARE FOR AND FOLLOW UP ON THESE CONSULTATIONS;
- A SCHEDULE OF CSCE REVIEW CONFERENCES ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS TO ASSESS PROGRESS TOWARD A EUROPE WHOLE AND FREE;
- A SMALL CSCE SECRETARIAT, PERHAPS IN PRAGUE, TO COORDINATE THESE MEETINGS AND CONFERENCES;
- A CSCE ELECTIONS COMMISSION, PERHAPS IN BUDAPEST, TO COORDINATE MONITORING OF FREE ELECTIONS;
- A CSCE CENTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF CONFLICT, PERHAPS IN WARSAW OR BERLIN, AS A FORUM FOR EXCHANGES OF MILITARY INFORMATION, DISCUSSION OF UNUSUAL MILITARY ACTIVITIES, AND THE CONCILIATION OF DISPUTES INVOLVING CSCE MEMBER STATES; AND
- A CSCE PARLIAMENTARY BODY, THE ASSEMBLY OF EUROPE, TO BE BASED ON THE EXISTING PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE, IN STRASBOURG, AND INCLUDE REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL

CSCE MEMBER STATES.

21. THIS ALLIANCE HAS DONE MUCH TO BRING ABOUT THE NEW
EUROPE. A UNITED GERMAN NATION WITH FULL MEMBERSHIP IN NATO WILL
BE AT THE HEART OF A EUROPE WHOLE AND FREE.
