The Soviets have just tabled (Tab I) a new version of their draft final settlement document. Most of the problematic elements were also in the earlier Soviet draft, and we reached a Western consensus on dealing with them at the One Plus Three Political Directors meeting in London August 23.

Two elements of the new draft are of particular concern. First, the Soviets continue to hold to language for the "termination," rather than "suspension," of Four Power rights. This would mean that those rights would remain in force after German unification (expected October 3) and until the settlement is ratified. While awaiting ratification by the various parliaments, the Soviets would retain veto power over the sovereignty of a united Germany.

Second, Article 6 of the Soviet draft includes this paragraph:

"Troop contingents of [the U.S., UK, and France] shall not cross the line coinciding with the present state border between the [GDR and FRG], except for movement of their troops belonging to the contingents stationed in Berlin. For their part, the troop contingents of the Soviet Union shall not cross the above-stated line either."

This language is virtually identical with the draft the West Germans tabled at the One Plus Three I attended in London, confirming my suspicion that an understanding has already been reached between Bonn and Moscow. It would apply even after the withdrawal of the last Soviet soldier from Germany, meaning that Allied forces could never "cross the line" for the purpose of exercises or in event of military conflict. This formulation, in our view, is incompatible with Germany's full NATO membership, particularly with Articles 5 and 6 of the North Atlantic Treaty.

With the British and French, we will continue to resist. If, as now seems likely, we cannot eliminate this idea altogether, we will insist on two stipulations: (1) this restriction would apply only during the transitional period in which Soviet forces remain in Germany and (2) it would be followed by an explicit statement to the effect that these measures shall not affect Germany's rights and obligations under Alliance membership.

In our draft letter to Kohl informing him of the President's objectives for the Helsinki meeting, we have included paragraphs touching on this issue, as well as on the related matter of our stationing rights and status of forces in the united Germany. The language is friendly and indirect, but its meaning will be understood, particularly after Secretary Baker's recent telephone call to Genscher and Ambassador Walters' separate demarches to Stoltenberg and Teltschik.

- Horst, I wanted to follow up briefly on the President's telephone conversation with the Chancellor.
- The President raised one issue at Two Plus Four that concerns us: the Soviet proposal that would forbid American, British, and French forces from "crossing the line" into the territory of the current GDR, even after the complete withdrawal of Soviet forces from Germany.
- I believe you understand our position -- that this stipulation could jeopardize Germany's full participation in NATO -- so I will not rehearse the details with you.
- The President said that Jim Baker would raise this in his meeting with the Chancellor. As that meeting will not take place until after the Two Plus Four Ministerial in Moscow on September 12, I wonder if you could look into the matter before then, with the President's concerns in mind.
- With a push from the Chancellery, I hope we will be able to work this out in a way that both of us -- and the Soviets as well -- are satisfied with.

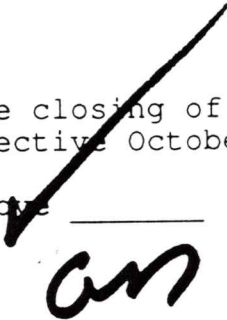
