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POINTS TO BE MADE FOR TELEPHONE CALL TO CHANCELLOR KOHL

- Helmut, let me first say how sorry I was to learn of the shooting of Minister Schaeuble (SHOY - bleh). I sent you a message to let you know we are praying for his recovery.
- Along with you, he deserves much of the credit for the CDU's impressive showing in the state elections in eastern Germany over the weekend. Congratulations!
- I will be looking forward to seeing you next month. It will be a good opportunity for us to talk about the U.S.-German relationship post-unification.
- I hoped that my visit would be able to symbolize U.S. support for unification. I also wanted to make some gesture to your new citizens in eastern Germany and to help you strengthen understanding of the Atlantic partnership in that part of Germany.
- That is why Berlin seemed the ideal location, particularly in that I was unable to accept your invitation for October 3.
- ((IF KOHL SAYS A STOP IN BERLIN WOULD STRENGTHEN MOMPER, THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC MAYOR)) I will defer to your judgment on this. Perhaps it can be arranged in a way that would not have this effect. Or perhaps a different location in eastern Germany could be selected.

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URUGUAY ROUND

- Helmut, let me also say a word about the Uruguay Round.
- We have put forward a new, more flexible agricultural proposal for GATT negotiations. The U.S. will also have a more flexible textile proposal.
- However, the agricultural proposal being debated within the EC falls far short of what other countries, including the developing countries, will find acceptable. The EC must be willing to negotiate reductions in all areas of agricultural support.
- We have little time left. A successful round hinges on meaningful agricultural reform.
- At Houston, we agreed to remain personally involved to make the necessary hard choices. I have tried to do my part, and I look to you to persuade the EC to adopt a more flexible position.
