SUBJECT: Reply to a Letter from President Rafael Angel Calderon of Costa Rica on the Enterprise for the Americas Initiative

Purpose

To express thanks for President Calderon's warm message of congratulations on the announcement of the Enterprise for the Americas Initiative.

Background

President Calderon wrote you on July 4, 1990 to congratulate you on the Initiative and to express Costa Rica's willingness to begin talks on a bilateral framework agreement (Tab B).

Your reply at Tab A says that the Initiative should provide real opportunities for Costa Rica to continue building on its recent economic successes. It expresses satisfaction that our consultations on a bilateral framework agreement have already begun, and closes with a kind word about Calderon's choice of Ambassador to the United States, Gonzalo Facio.

Subject: Suggested Response from the President to
Costa Rican President Rafael Calderon Regarding
the "Enterprise for the Americas" Initiative

Attached is a suggested response from President Bush to Costa Rican President Rafael Calderon's letter of July 4 concerning the "Enterprise for the Americas" Initiative. In his letter, Calderon congratulated the President on the announcement of the initiative and offered Costa Rica's support for the proposal. The Costa Rican President specifically cited President Bush's call for free markets and, while welcoming the opportunity to enter discussions towards a bilateral trade agreement with the U.S., raised concerns regarding the effect elimination of trade barriers would have on Costa Rican businesses. Calderon also applauded the President's focus on the environment in announcing the initiative.

The Department's suggested reply expresses the President's appreciation for Calderon's support and encouragement. The reply does not refer to specific policy issues raised by the Costa Rican President although it reiterates President Bush's goal for liberalized trade policies.

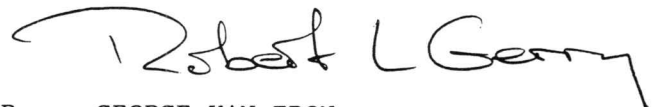
