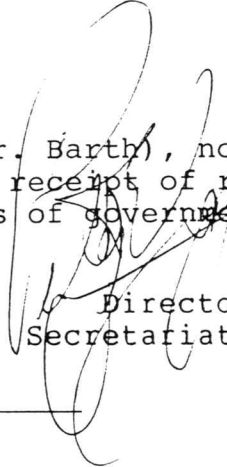

Subject: Response to King Fahd's letter to the
President on Lebanon

Saudi Arabian King Fahd recently wrote to President Bush asking for a U.S. contribution to the proposed International Fund for Assistance to Lebanon (IFAL), and asking the United States to send a representative to the IFAL donor pledging conference to be held in Saudi Arabia on September 10-11, 1990. The incoming letter is attached.

We believe that the recent Iraqi invasion of Kuwait will seriously affect the IFAL proposal and that a response would be inappropriate at this time. We will hold the incoming correspondence and forward a draft response when the situation in the Persian Gulf and its effects on the IFAL proposal become clearer. In the meantime, we will inform the Saudis informally that a response has been delayed due to the events in the Persian Gulf.

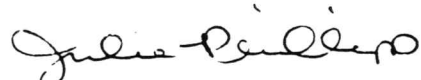

Heads of State Correspondence Summary

President Andreotti of Italy - August 14, 1990
(Received August 17)

President Andreotti acknowledges your July 20 letter concerning Soviet reforms. He also informs you of his July 26 visit to the USSR and notes his support for Gorbachev's political reforms.

He states that Gorbachev has launched a measure of reforms set "to create favorable internal conditions fostering economic cooperation with the Western countries". He also remarks that Gorbachev "stressed several times that the U.S. should maintain an important role in Europe".

Andreotti notes that the Soviet reform plan will be launched in September and that by December the international community should have a basis from which it can formulate decisions on how best to support these political and economic reforms. He hopes for continued international collaboration on these matters.

President Callejas of Honduras - August 16, 1990

President Callejas requests a meeting with you, around the time of his UN address on August 27-30, to discuss bilateral issues.

President Perez of Venezuela - August 14, 1990
(Received August 20)

President Perez appreciates your August 3 letter concerning the postponement of your visit to Latin America. He fully understands the reasons for the delay and suggests that a new date be set at a mutually convenient time. He looks forward to strengthening trade relations in accordance with your Latin Economic Initiative.

President Aylwin acknowledges your August 7 letter and understands the reasons for the postponement of your trip to Latin America. He would be happy to receive you in late November or early December. PRES NOTED SUMMARY

THIS IS THE UNOFFICIAL TRANSLATION OF THE LETTER ADDRESSED TO T.H. GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, FROM T.H. GIULIO ANDREOTTI, PRIME MINISTER OF ITALY.

"Dear George,

I would like to thank you for your letter of July 20 in which you gave a follow up on the agreement reached about the Soviet Union in Houston.

My visit to Moscow on July 26, accompanied by the Foreign Minister Gianni De Michelis, had the purpose of moving forward in this same direction. In fact, speaking on behalf of the entire European Community, I wanted to confirm our full support for the political reforms undertaken by President Gorbaciov and express our wish that it could bring about positive results at the earliest date.

On his part, the Soviet President described in detail the projects for reform which he intends to launch, pointing out that the purpose of said measures is to create favorable internal conditions fostering economic cooperation with the Western Countries.

He also stressed several times that the United States should maintain an important role in Europe, a point I wished to reiterate at the press conference held at the end of our talks.

Since the Soviet reform plan shall be launched in September, the Monetary Fund and the other International Organizations will be able to take it into account in the framework of the study which was entrusted to them by the Houston Summit.

This way in December it will be possible to have a complete backdrop of the context in which we might formulate our decisions for a concerted action which appears increasingly necessary to support the process of political and economic reform in the USSR, beyond what the individual countries can do on a bilateral scale to confront any contingent problems.

This is a subject upon which we must continue our tight collaboration. On my part I will keep you updated on the developments which will likely emerge in the European Council this Fall, based on the results of the inquiry entrusted to the Commission from the Council of Dublin.

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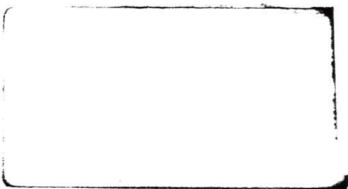

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: RULING OF THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS

Pursuant to our conversation this morning, I am pleased to report that the Railroad Commission of Texas today adopted an emergency rule to increase the State's oil production. For a period of 90 days, beginning August 31, 1990, oil wells will be allowed to produce at capacity. The Commission is optimistic that 20,000 to 30,000 B/D of additional production will accrue from this ruling. The East Texas field is not included in this decision, but will be considered at the Commission's September 20, 1990, meeting. As I mentioned this morning, we did not anticipate such a favorable outcome.

The Texas decision coupled with the increase in surge production from Alaska, plus the increase from the Naval Petroleum Reserve, will give us an increase of 251,000 to 261,000 B/D for the last quarter of this year. This fundamentally guarantees the objective of our immediate response measures announced two weeks ago.
