MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: President's National Security Briefing



The following subjects were discussed.

- The President raised a question about a reference he had read about turning over the Panama Canal under the terms of the Treaty. There was some discussion of when a Panamanian will become chairman of the Canal Commission and when control of the Canal will pass to the Panamanians. (ACTION: Gates to get timetable.)
- Scowcroft gave the President a copy of Kissinger's trip report and a letter from Gorbachev. They agreed on a meeting Saturday morning in the Oval Office for Kissinger to provide a review of his trip. (ACTION: Scowcroft -- arrange with Kissinger, also attendance.)
- Scowcroft raised the famous Soviet cake. The President clearly regards it as a serious gesture of goodwill by the co-op in Moscow and would like to do more than just a simple acknowledgement. He mentioned the possibility of having a

picture of Mrs. Bush with the cake or of his son Marvin or some such. (ACTION: Gates - Executive Secretary to talk to Jennifer Fitzgerald in State protocol and Susan Porter Rose about possible ways to accommodate the President's desire to be responsive.)

-- Further telephone calls in response to congratulatory messages were discussed. The President agreed to call Hawke of Australia, Hussein of Jordan and King Fahd of Saudi Arabia. We agreed to check on whether or not there had been a message from Shamir. Sununu indicated that a message had been passed informally from the Saudis and that he would provide a copy.

-- There was further discussion of the Boren/Danforth meeting. The question came up how large it should be. If it included all of those proposed in their letter it would include about 20 people. Considerable discussion about the meeting with the Vice President particularly expressing concern about having the meeting on exactly the terms that they had proposed. He said they would take that as a commitment to an institutional approach and a mechanism for consultation that the President should not sign up to. It was agreed that the attendance therefore would not parallel their

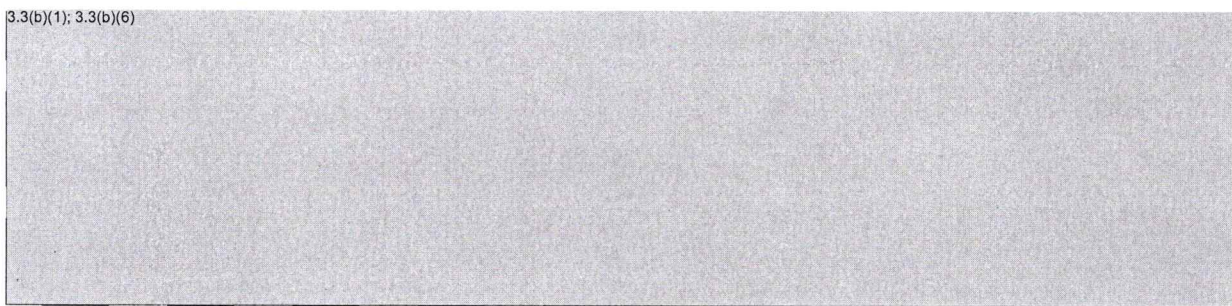

proposal but would include the six signatories to the letter, the five leaders of the Congress and perhaps two to four parallel members of the House of Representatives. It was also agreed that the talking points would indicate the President's flexibility, that he did not see this as an institutional mechanism but basically his eagerness to listen and have their views on a consultative process.

- Scowcroft indicated that State would be preparing routine acknowledgements from the President for congratulatory messages in those cases where the President had not made a phone call.

- Sununu raised the request by Gordy Sax to meet with the President for 15 minutes before and 15 minutes after his trip to Israel. There was agreement that the President would not meet with him alone. Sununu clearly did not want a meeting before the Sax trip to Israel. Disposition was

The President also indicated a willingness to have someone from the Agency like Bob Blackwell, but acknowledged HAK might not like so many from outside the White House.

-- Gates raised additional congratulatory messages from Assad of Syria, Hussein of Jordan, Najibullah of Afghanistan.

-- The President asked if Prerz of Venezuela knows the Vice President is coming. The Vice President's trip was then discussed and the decision was made that he would visit only Venezuela and El Salvador.

-- The Vice President mentioned that Speaker Wright has asked him to carry a message to President-Elect Perez of Venezuela indicating the Speakers desire. He said the Speaker was eager to work with the Administration. He had not gone down there but asked that this message be delivered. There was no objection to this, although Gates raised the question whether the Vice President should be delivering mail from the Speaker. It was agreed the Vice President would simply hand off the message to Perez's military aid.

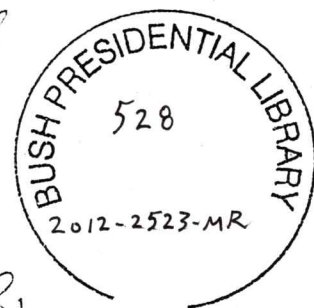
