DEAR HOSNI:

THIS MORNING WE WILL BE GOING PUBLIC WITH OUR EVIDENCE DETAILING
LIBYA'S ROLE IN THE PAN AM 103 TRAGEDY AND IN TERRORISM MORE
BROADLY. WHAT EMERGES IS A CLEAR AND TO MY MIND PERSUASIVE CASE
OF LIBYAN INVOLVEMENT IN AND SUPPORT FOR SUCH ACTIVITY. WHAT WE
WILL BE ASKING OF THE LIBYA GOVERNMENT IS THAT IT ACCEPT COMPLETE
RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ACTIONS OF LIBYAN OFFICIALS AND SURRENDER
FOR TRIAL ALL THOSE CHARGED, COOPERATE FULLY WITH THE
INVESTIGATION. AND PAY COMPENSATION. IN ADDITION, WE ARE

DON. THE PRESIDENT HAS CONCLUDED THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO POSTPONE

DEAR HELMUT:

I HAVE JUST CONCLUDED MY DISCUSSIONS IN THE HAGUE WITH RUUD
LUBBERS AND JACQUES DELORS ON THE URUGUARY ROUND, AND I WANTED
PROMPTLY TO SHARE WITH YOU MY IMPRESSION OF WHERE WE ARE ON THIS
VITALLY IMPORTANT MATTER.

KNOWING THAT THE EC WAS READY TO CONSIDER SOME FLEXIBILITY
ON AGRICULTURE, THANKS TO YOUR EFFORTS, THE U.S. HAS MADE RECENT
MOVES IN THE AREAS OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS, MARKET
ACCESS, AND SERVICES. AS A CONSEQUENCE, THE US AND THE EC HAVE
BEEN ABLE TO NARROW OUR DIFFERENCES IN THESE AREAS DOWN TO A FEW
TOUGH ISSUES WHICH, WITH SOME FURTHER GIVE AND TAKE, WE SHOULD BE
ABLE TO SETTLE. IN FACT, RUUD, JACQUES AND I EXPLICITLY AGREED
THAT IF WE CAN RESOLVE OUR DIFFERENCES IN AGRICULTURE, WE CAN
SURELY RESOLVE -- AND ARE COMMITTED TO RESOLVE -- THESE OTHER
