DEAR GEORGE

DEAR GENERAL SCOWCROFT

I should tell you, before it becomes public, of a French initiative concerning nuclear tests. This initiative will be announced to our National Assembly this afternoon by Mr. Roland Dumas, Minister of Foreign Affairs.

We have noticed that some nuclear powers have, like ourselves, announced their decision to suspend their nuclear tests for a limited period. The timing of these initiatives leads one to believe that this question has reached a point where a common consideration on the part of the five nuclear powers is now opportune.

This is why we are proposing that the five countries have a common discussion on this subject. Bearing in mind the nature of this enterprise, we think that the most appropriate method would be to entrust this task to our ambassadors at the Conference for Disarmament.

We would be pleased if our partners follow up on this proposition so that the representatives of the five nuclear powers in Geneva can very shortly broach this question.

Mr. Roland Dumas is today sending a letter to the Foreign Ministers of China, the United States, Great Britain and Russia to tell them of this proposition. We hope that it will be favorably received by your government.

Please accept, dear General Scowcroft, the assurance of my most cordial sentiments.

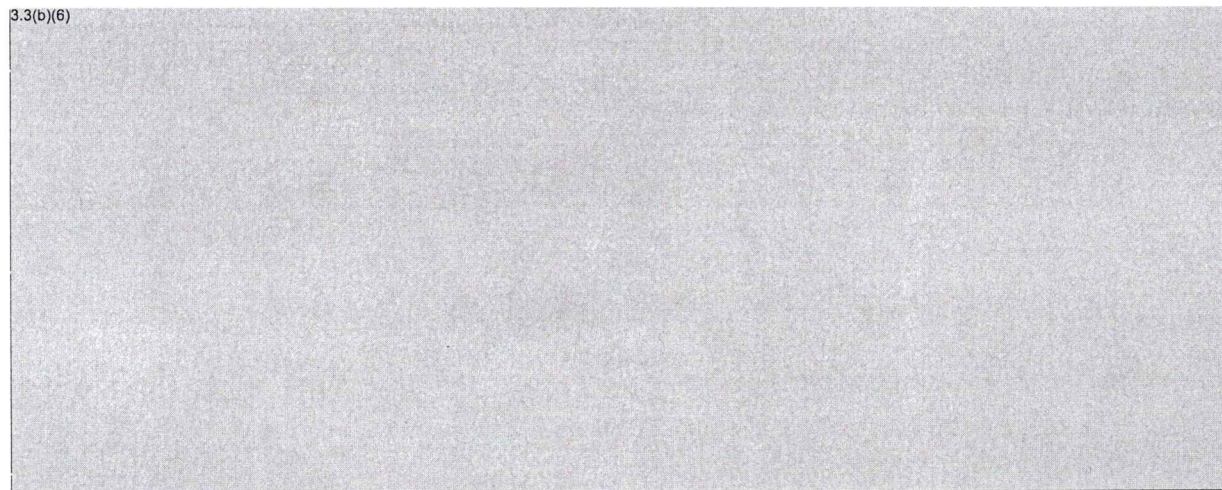

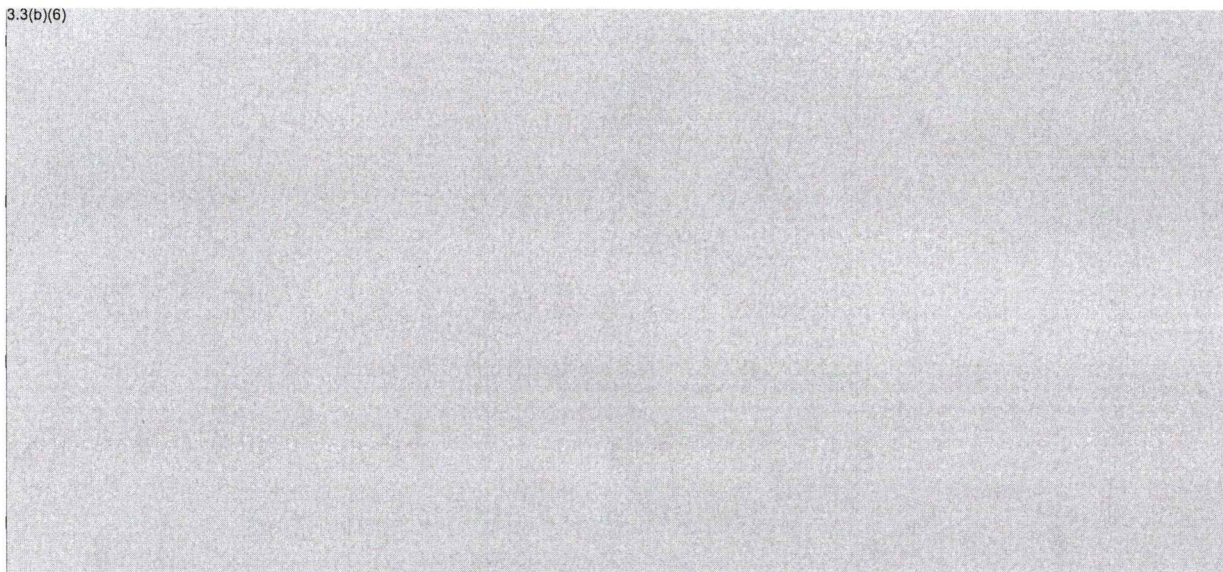

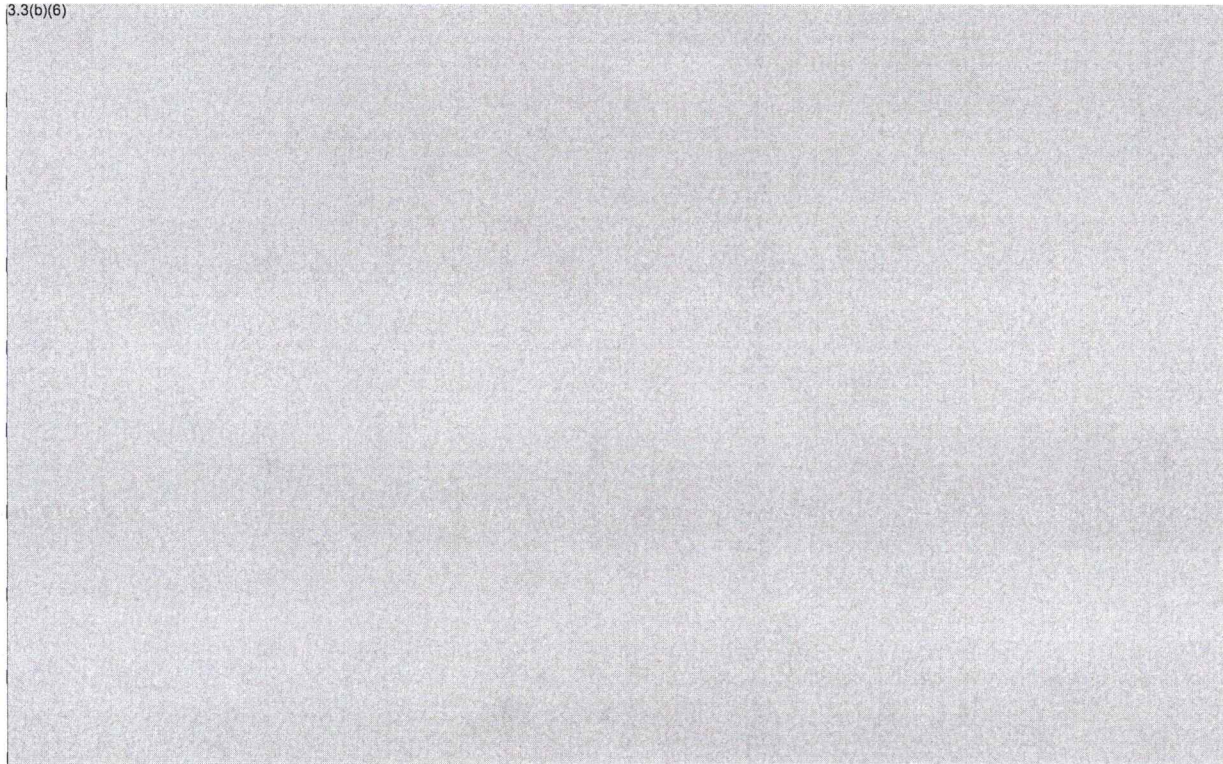

Dear George:

I am responding to your letter of October 15, concerning the developments of the Uruguay Round negotiations.

I fully agree that it is desirable to come to a positive and constructive conclusion of the negotiations as soon as possible. At the European Council meeting in Birmingham on October 16, and after, we insisted with particular vigour on the necessity to reach this objective, however, as you know, a differentiation of views within the Community has become apparent, which we are making efforts to overcome.

Today, a meeting of the agriculture ministers of the Twelve will take place in Luxembourg, which could provide an occasion to allow McSharry to resume the negotiation with his American counterparts.

Let me add only that this task to which we feel strongly committed will be made easier by the willingness on the part of

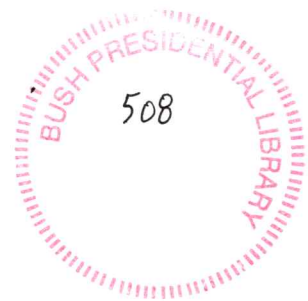

NOT ONLY HAVE WE GONE AS FAR AS WE CAN WITHOUT JEOPARDIZING CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL OF A NEW AGREEMENT HERE, BUT WE HAVE ADDRESSED EVERY MAJOR EUROPEAN CONCERN. TO GET THIS FAR, THE U.S. HAS MOVED SIGNIFICANTLY IN EVERY AREA WHERE WE WERE DIVIDED -- INCLUDING MARKET ACCESS, SERVICES, INTERNAL SUPPORTS IN AGRICULTURE AND AGRICULTURAL EXPORT SUBSIDIES. AGREEMENT ON THESE TWO ISSUES, WE FACE THE SPECTER OF ESCALATING TRADE CONFLICTS AT THE VERY TIME THE FUTURE OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRADING SYSTEM IS CALLED INTO QUESTION.

LET ME REVIEW WHAT THE U.S. HAS DONE TO PRODUCE AN AGREEMENT. THE EC TOLD US THAT IT NEEDED PROGRESS IN OTHER AREAS TO JUSTIFY COMPROMISE IN AGRICULTURE. ACCORDINGLY, WE HAVE SHOWN FLEXIBILITY, AND AS A RESULT WE HAVE NARROWED U.S.-EC DIFFERENCES IN ALL AREAS, INCLUDING FINANCIAL SERVICES, WHERE OUR POSITION IS NOW THE SAME AS THAT OF THE EC.

I KNOW THIS FRIDAY'S SUMMIT IN BIRMINGHAM IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR YOU AND FOR THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY. I SINCERELY HOPE THAT YOU AND YOUR COLLEAGUES CAN FIND SOME WAY IN BIRMINGHAM TO AUTHORIZE FRANS ANDRIESSEN TO WORK ON THE BASIS OF OUR COMPROMISE PROPOSALS TO ACHIEVE A U.S.-EC UNDERSTANDING. WITH THAT ACHIEVED, WE COULD BOTH RETURN TO GENEVA TO WORK WITH OUR OTHER TRADING PARTNERS FOR A COMPREHENSIVE URUGUAY ROUND ACCORD.

I HOPE YOU WILL WORK WITH JOHN MAJOR, HELMUT KOHL AND OTHERS TO BRING ABOUT THIS VITALLY IMPORTANT AGREEMENT. YOUR SUPPORT AND LEADERSHIP WILL BE INVALUABLE.
