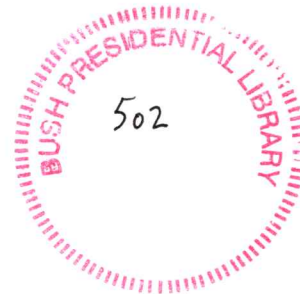

PROBLEM WITH DUNKEL'S PROPOSAL ON EXPORT SUBSIDIES, AND WE HAVE NOW MADE AN OFFER THAT IS LESS DEMANDING THAN DUNKEL. THE EC AS A WHOLE WANTED ITS NEW CAP REFORM PAYMENTS SPARED IN A NEW GATT AGREEMENT, AND WE HAVE MADE GOOD ON THAT. AND OF COURSE, YOU WANTED TO PUT OFF FINAL NEGOTIATIONS UNTIL AFTER SEPTEMBER 20 SO THAT THEY WOULD NOT IMPERIL THE CRITICAL MAASTRICHT REFERENDUM, AND WE HONORED THAT REQUEST. NOT ONLY HAVE WE GONE AS FAR AS WE CAN WITHOUT JEOPARDIZING CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL OF A NEW AGREEMENT HERE, BUT WE HAVE ADDRESSED EVERY MAJOR EUROPEAN CONCERN. AND, I THINK YOU WILL FIND THAT YOUR BASIC CRITERIA HAVE BEEN MET.

THE WORLD IS WAITING FOR EUROPE AND THE UNITED STATES TO LEAD THE WAY TO A NEW TRADE AGREEMENT, AS WE PROMISED WE WOULD. THE POOR AND DEVELOPING COUNTRIES DESPERATELY NEED THIS AGREEMENT. OUR OWN ECONOMIES CONTINUE TO LANGUISH; A NEW TRADE AGREEMENT WOULD GET US ALL MOVING AGAIN. FINANCIAL MARKETS AND THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY NEED A STRONG SIGNAL FROM THE WORLD'S LEADERS. WE HAVE AT HAND AN OPPORTUNITY TO DO SO MUCH FOR THE WORLD ECONOMY, I FEAR WE WILL NOT BE FORGIVEN IF WE LET IT SLIP THROUGH OUR HANDS.

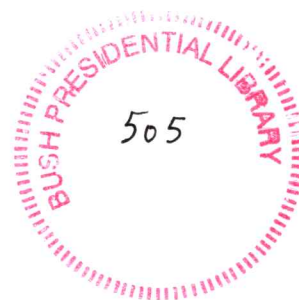

DEAR HUBERT:

PRESIDENT BUSH IS COMMUNICATING HIS SENTIMENTS DIRECTLY IN A
PERSONAL MESSAGE, BUT I WANTED TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO
UNDERScore OUR CONCERN FOR PRESIDENT MITTERRAND'S HEALTH AND OUR
SINCERE BEST WISHES FOR HIS RAPID RECOVERY.

I AM ALSO WRITING TODAY TO URGE THAT WE COME TO AGREEMENT SOON ON
AN ESSENTIAL ASPECT OF OUR COMMON EFFORTS REGARDING IRAQ -- THE
TEXT OF A UN SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FROZEN IRAQI
ASSETS TO THE UN. WE HAVE REACHED AGREEMENT WITH YOUR EXPERTS ON
ALL BUT ONE ELEMENT OF THE RESOLUTION.

THE OUTSTANDING DIFFERENCE IS PARAGRAPH ELEVEN WHICH PROHIBITS
ANYONE FROM TRANSFERRING ASSETS EXCEPT VIA THE UN. THIS IS AN
IMPORTANT ELEMENT OF THE RESOLUTION WHICH GUARANTEES UN SUPERVISION
OF ANY UNFROZEN ASSETS. IT WILL INCREASE THE PRESSURE ON SADDAM TO
ACCEPT RESOLUTIONS 706 AND 712 AND DEMONSTRATE THAT THE UN GRIP IS
GETTING TIGHTER.

THE PROVISION WOULD NOT PREVENT FUNDS FROM BEING USED FOR
HUMANITARIAN AID; ON THE CONTRARY, IT WOULD ENSURE THAT THEY COULD
ONLY BE USED FOR HUMANITARIAN AID, SINCE THE UN WOULD MONITOR THEIR
USE. MOREOVER, THE RESOLUTION MAKES NEW SOURCES OF FUNDING
AVAILABLE FOR HUMANITARIAN RELIEF. IT WILL ALSO PROHIBIT THE BANK

IT IS BEING PRESSURED TO DO.

SO. ASSETS RELEASED TO IRAQ BY OTHER COUNTRIES, PRIVATE UNFROZEN
HARD CURRENCY ACCOUNTS, AND FUTURE OIL DELIVERIES HAVE ALL BEEN
USED BY IRAQ TO SECURE IMPORTANT FINANCING SINCE THE GULF WAR.
GOODS IMPORTED HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO SADDAM'S CRONIES AND
VULNERABLE GROUPS HAVE BEEN DENIED ACCESS TO ESSENTIAL CIVILIAN
GOODS. RECENT REPORTS FROM BULGARIA REGARDING ARMS SHIPMENTS AND
