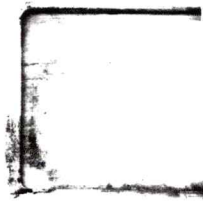
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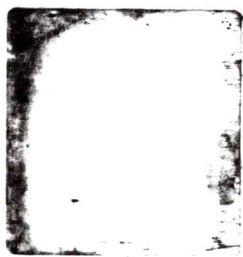

It was a pleasure to talk to you again today, and this is to confirm our conversation giving you the go-ahead to proceed with casting of the Make Way for Ducklings Statue in preparation for its donation by the United States to the Soviet Union, particularly to the children of the Soviet Union. This is a lovely idea. With the concurrence of both the Soviets and the Americans, an appropriate park for the statue is being sought in Moscow.

We are delighted to learn that a group of private citizens in Boston has agreed to raise the money necessary to cover the costs of its casting, transit, and installation. We would hope to work closely with you in order that the new sculpture would be properly sited, delivered, and installed. No dates have been set for a summit at which the completed statue could be visited and dedicated by Mrs. Gorbachev and Mrs. Bush, however, the hope would be to proceed immediately in the event such a meeting were to be possible after the first of the year. I also look forward to working with Robert McCloskey with the hope of having Make Way for Ducklings translated into Russian and available for Mrs. Bush to take it with her to Moscow.

I know Mrs. Bush would want me to convey her deep appreciation to you for this most generous offer and also to all who will be contributing to the ultimate success of this wonderful project.
