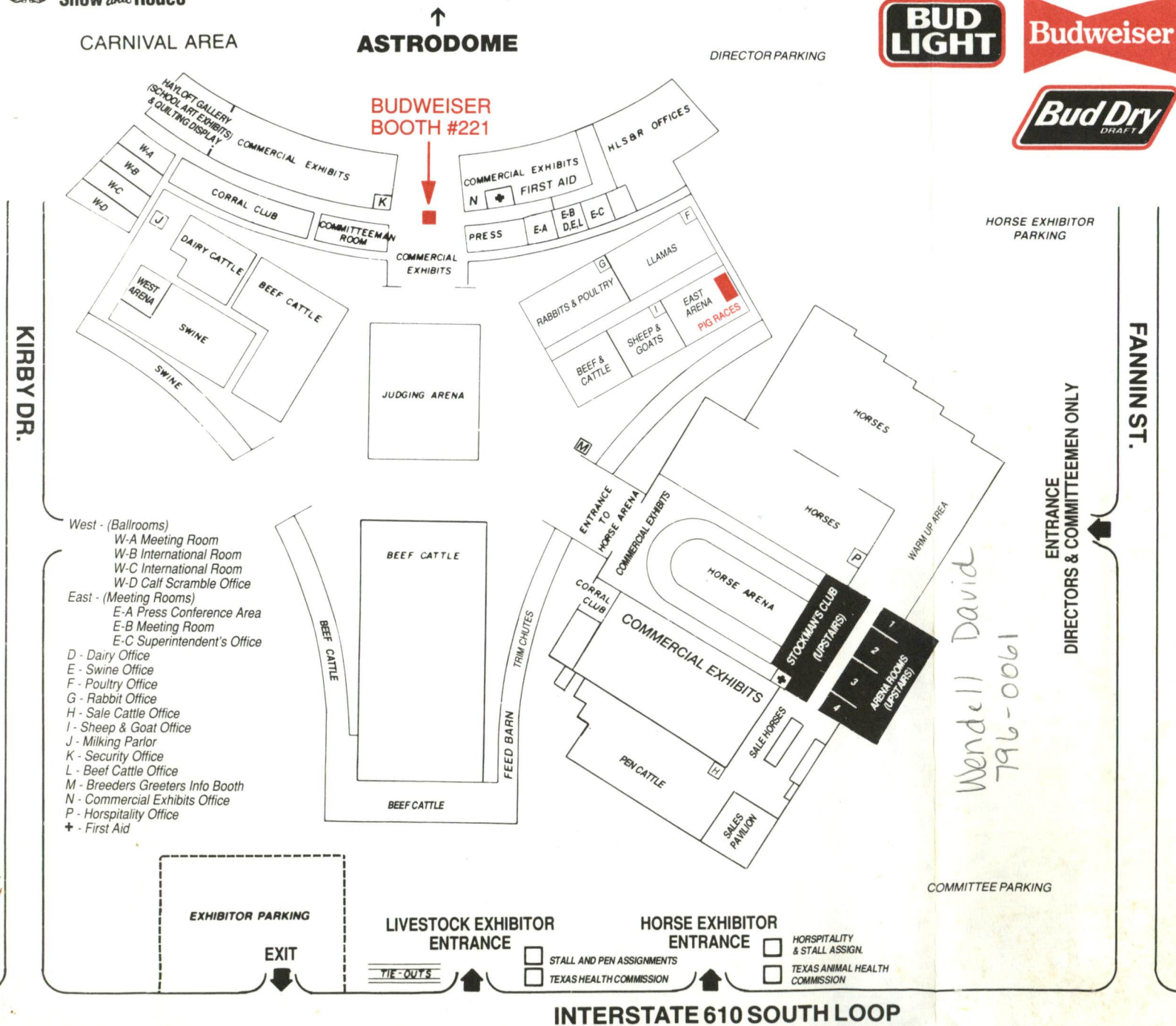

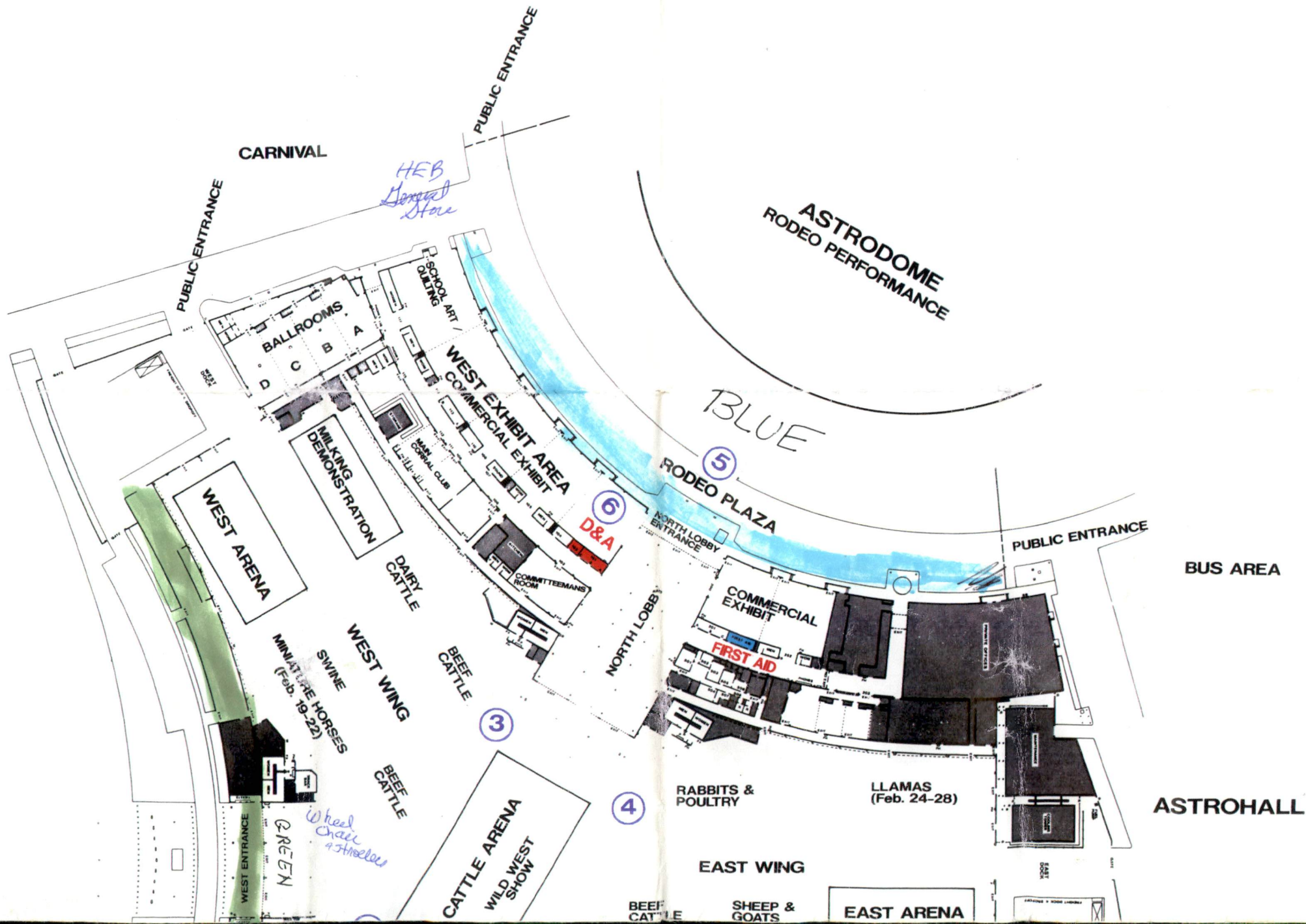

POLICY STATEMENT

GOLD BADGES

HOUSTON LIVESTOCK SHOW & RODEO

I. Policy objective: to document guidelines and procedures to be used in the annual distribution/management of gold badges.

II. General Information/Procedures

- A. Gold badges are non-transferable and are for the exclusive use of the individuals to whom they are issued. The act of loaning, giving or selling badges to other individuals is strictly prohibited.
- B. Gold badges shall not be issued to individuals under the age of sixteen (16). Exceptions to the minimum age may be made by the General Manager if unique circumstances exist.
- C. Committeemen shall receive only one (1) gold badge for committee participation regardless of the number of committees on which they serve. Additional gold badges may be received by other means such as being a champion buyer or calf scramble donor.
- D. Any member/individual found to be duplicating or attempting to reproduce gold badges, parking permits or other similar items without written permission from the General Manager may be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law and/or permanently expelled from Show membership.
- E. Gold badges issued which subsequently become stolen or lost may be replaced if the badge holder submits a written statement to the General Manager's office documenting the extenuating circumstances. Depending on the expressed circumstances involved, the Show shall not be obligated to replace a gold badge that has been lost or stolen.
- F. Directors of the Show, in lieu of committee participation, shall be issued a gold badge due to their position on the Board of Directors. Directors shall also receive one (1) official badge for their spouse or guest. In cases where a spouse participates on a badged committee, the gold badge earned by the spouse shall also be issued as stated in II. C. above.
- G. Current Officers and Executive Committee Members shall be issued a gold badge due to their position as an Officer/Executive Committee Member of the Show. Current Officers/Executive Committee Members shall also receive five (5) guest badges for their guests and/or personal use in public relations endeavors and promotional activities related to the Show. In addition, current Officers/Executive Committee Members who are married shall receive a personalized badge for their spouse. The spouse's name shall be engraved on the badge.

- H. Gold badges shall be issued to staff, specified guests, superintendents, judges, and etc. as deemed appropriate and necessary. Such badges shall be issued by the President's/General Manger's office for the expressed purpose of conducting daily duties/responsibilities, public relations endeavors and general promotional activities related to the Show.
- I. Individuals issued gold badges shall adhere to the rules, procedures and guidelines expressed herein. Under no circumstances shall individuals receive more than one (1) gold badge except in cases as stated herein. Proven abuse of badge privileges shall be considered grounds for forfeiture of the badge and possible revocation of Show membership. Conduct of badge holders should always be positive and consistent with the aims, purposes, character and integrity of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo.

III...Badge Privileges

-A. Gold badges shall provide admission to: (1) the rodeo for the badge holder and one guest per performance; (2) the World's Championship Barbecue, livestock show and horse show for the badge holder and one guest per day; and (3) unlimited use of the rodeo shuttle bus for the badge holder only.
-B. During Rodeo performances in the Astrodome, gold badges provide entry to the field box, mezzanine, and upper levels. Gold badges do not provide entry to certain restricted areas as listed in III. C.
-C. Gold badges shall not provide parking privilege or admission to various restricted areas such as the executive suites, skyboxes, fifth and sixth (loge) levels of the Astrodome, corral clubs, rodeo grand entry, rodeo chute area, entertainer dressing rooms, judging rings/arenas, and etc.

Non-HLSR members with experience in working with the visually impaired are to sign up for shifts designated as **Sight Assistance**.

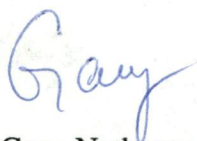
Individuals with experience in working with any other areas are encouraged to sign up for shifts identified as **Special Needs**.

- ♦ Bus service starts Saturday, February 20, 1993.

- ♦ The bus rides terminate on the Astrodome parking lot immediately adjacent to the permanent HLSR office. A great location that is the center of rodeo activities. Passengers disembark to an area covered by a series of very large white tents that provides excellent protection from the hot sun or rain. The tents provide an excellent place to wait for your bus ride back to your park and ride lot of origin.

- ◆ Bus service starts Saturday, February 20, 1993.

- ◆ The bus rides terminate on the Astrodome parking lot immediately adjacent to the permanent HLSR office. A great location that is the center of rodeo activities. Passengers disembark to an area covered by a series of very large white tents that provides excellent protection from the hot sun or rain. The tents provide an excellent place to wait for your bus ride back to your park and ride lot of origin.

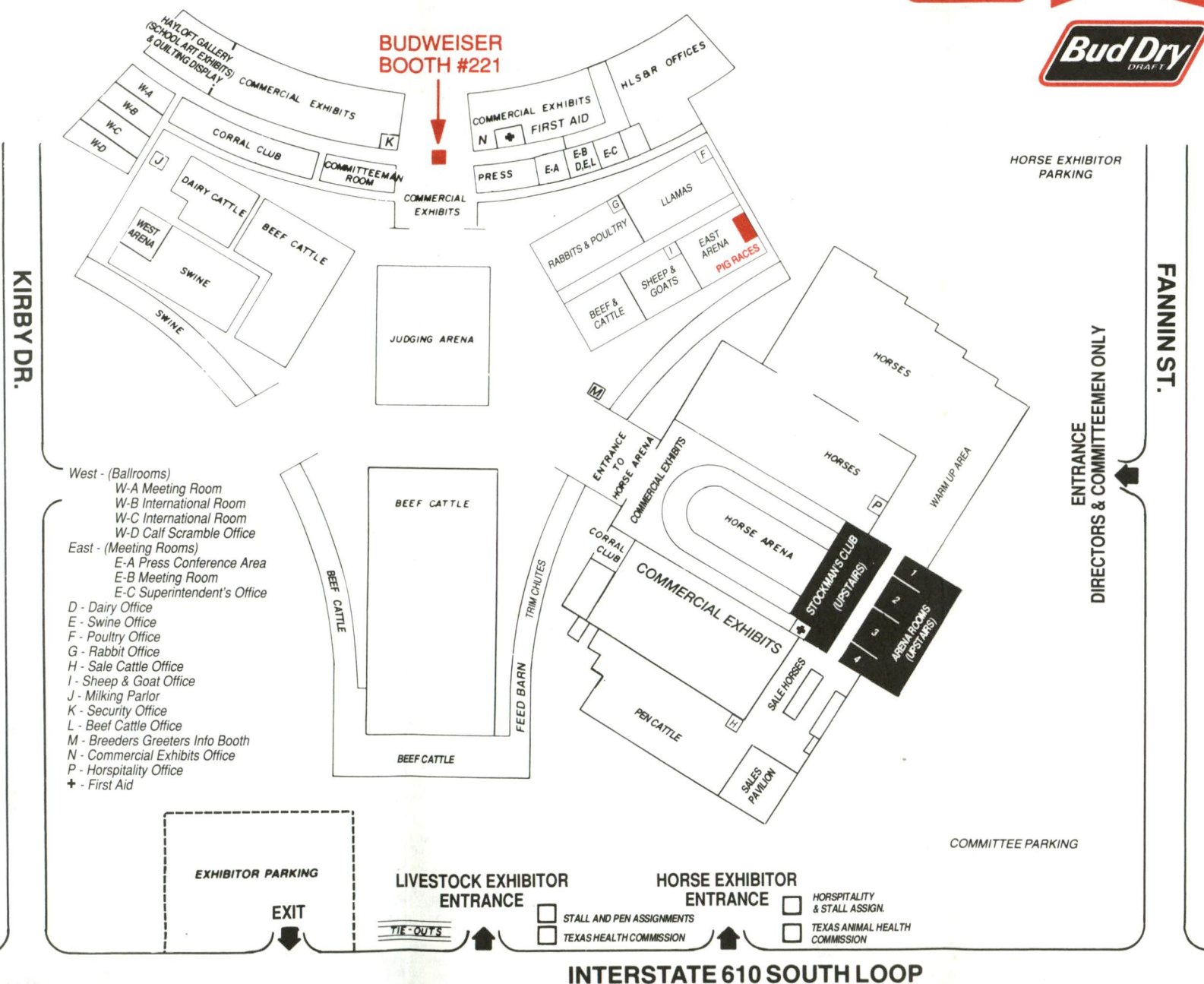

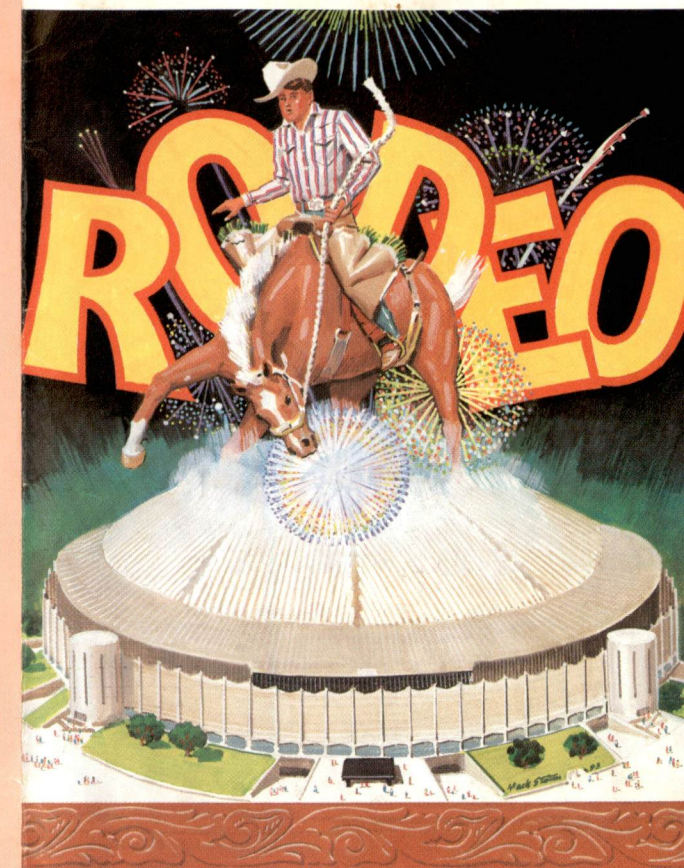
