The clinical genetics program of the Institute for Molecular Genetics is a coordinated effort of four primary clinical activities. One is the Birth Defects-Genetics Clinic and consultation service which provides screening, diagnostic evaluation, treatment, and prevention services to children with birth defects and genetic disorders. Second is the Prenatal Diagnosis Clinic which provides prenatal diagnosis, counseling, amniocentesis, ultrasound, fetoscopy, along with cytogenetic and metabolic laboratory services. Third is the metabolic service which follows children with treatable inborn errors of metabolism. Fourth is the maternal serum alpha fetoprotein screening program.
