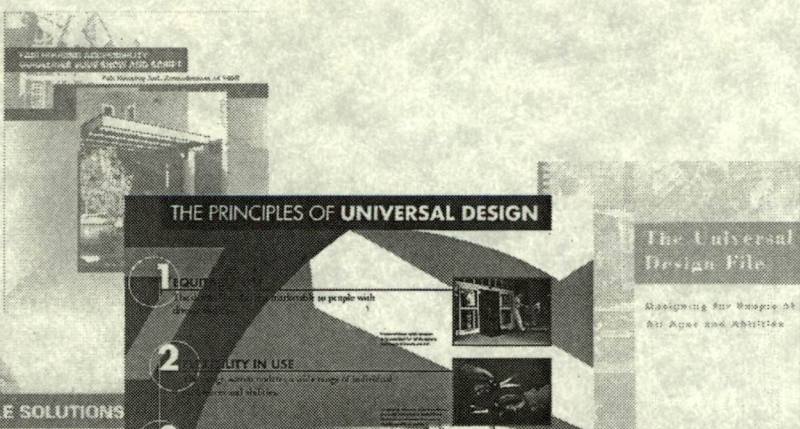

THE PRINCIPLES OF UNIVERSAL DESIGN

- 1 **EQUITY IN USE**
The design should be usable by as many people with diverse abilities as possible.
- 2 **FEASIBILITY IN USE**
Design should accommodate a wide range of individual physical and mental abilities.
- 3 **SIMPLE AND INTUITIVE USE**
Use of the design is easy to understand for the widest possible range of people, regardless of their experience, knowledge, or current concentration level.
- 4 **PERCEPTIBLE INFORMATION**
The design communicates necessary and useful information effectively to the user, regardless of the user's sensory abilities.
- 5 **TOLERANCE FOR ERROR**
The design minimizes hazards and the consequences of accidental or unintended actions.
- 6 **LOW PHYSICAL EFFORT**
The design can be used efficiently, comfortably, and with a minimum of fatigue.
- 7 **SPACE FOR APPROACH AND MANEUVERING**
The design provides appropriate space for people to approach, reach, manipulate, and move within.

ADA defined requirements describe different types of pedestrian routes through a given facility. Some of the routes describe accessible routes in historic properties, work areas, and dwelling units. Design specifications include width and height, surface textures, slope, doors and levels.

Areas of Rescue Assistance
ADAARA.4.3.11 22 pp. 1994 \$5.00

ADA requires a safe waiting area to be provided at or near inaccessible exits for people who cannot climb stairs. This booklet also describes the importance of two-way communication systems when building evacuation is necessary.
