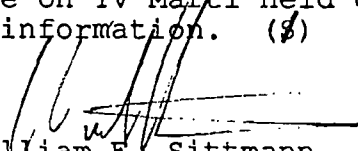

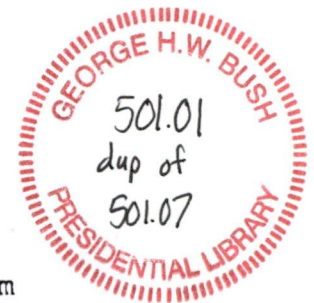

Summary of Conclusions

It was agreed that:

- TV Marti broadcasts from Cudjoe Key should begin on Wednesday, March 14, 1990, in the 6 a.m. - 9 a.m. time period, or as soon as practical thereafter if there is a further delay caused by the weather. (Sunday broadcasts will take place from 5:00 - 8:00 a.m.) (S)
- The State Department and USIA will make final determinations on which Congressmen should be notified in advance. The talking points should not give a specific time for the beginning of broadcasts and should emphasize that Congress should handle this with discretion to maximize our chance of getting a signal in. Assuming TV Marti broadcasts on March 14, notifications should take place on Tuesday morning, March 13. (S)

- Assuming TV Marti broadcasts on March 14, FCC will advise the broadcasters on Tuesday afternoon, (March 13) that TV Marti will begin soon. (S)
- (b)(1);(b)(3) Geneva will be notified three hours before the tests are to begin. (S)
- Entertainment programming will be used for two weeks, and the NSC/PCC will then consider the programming issue. (S)
- U.S. policy is to avoid harmful interference to Cuban broadcasts. The Deputies Committee endorsed the procedures for avoiding interference specified in the paper prepared for the meeting by the NSC/PCC. It was decided that TV Marti would cease broadcasting temporarily in the case of simultaneous Cuban transmitting on Channel 13 with Cuban jamming of the TV Marti signal. (S)

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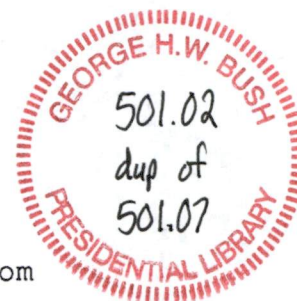
