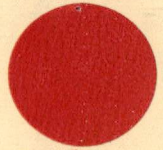

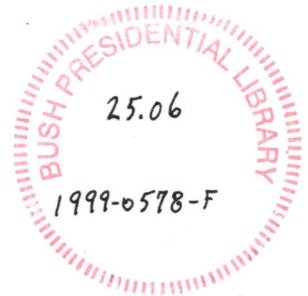

Summary of Conclusions

The Deputies Committee principals agreed on the following course of action for specific U.S. programs with Iraq: (S)

- On the CCC program, to continue with the first tranche but to defer a decision on the second until ongoing Department of Justice and Department of Agriculture investigations were completed. This decision would be conveyed to Iraq through technical channels to avoid making it appear to be a political decision (C);
- On the EXIM credit program, to let the presidential waiver stand. Treasury and State would work with EXIM review the projects involved on a case-by-case basis and provide EXIM with guidance as appropriate (C);
- On licensing and trade, to focus on the MTCR. Commerce should proceed with the proposal with the idea of consulting in early July with the other regime members to tighten up export controls. (C)

Assuming agency principals had no objection to these positions by close of business, Wednesday, May 30, 1990, appropriate instructions would be conveyed to our Embassy in Baghdad. (C)

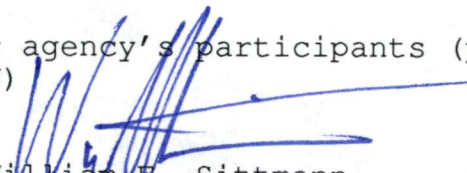
