Summary of Conclusions

For the COCOM High Level Meeting on June 6-7, it was agreed, subject to concurrence by principals, that:

- On telecommunications, the U.S. could agree to common channel signalling for Eastern Europe provided that:  
(a) the Eastern European governments establish effective safeguard regimes to prevent diversion to the USSR; and (b) such liberalized treatment does not apply to the USSR. (S)
- The PCC on Technology Transfer should accelerate work on safeguard regimes for Eastern Europe. (S)

- On computers, the U.S. could propose a modified Administrative Exceptions Note (AEN) procedure for computers along the following lines:

Computers with Processing Data Rate (PDR) of:

275-400: Normal AEN treatment  
400-500: Modified AEN treatment with 30-day prior notification to permit bilateral representations to licensing countries  
550-1000: Favorable consideration (C)

- Should the allies fail to agree to the revised computer proposal, U.S. negotiators should seek guidance from Washington. In that event, the Deputies will reconvene to consider the issue. (C)
- The U.S. can propose a system of differentiation between Eastern Europe and the USSR which calls for favorable treatment on all but 16 list categories for those Eastern European countries that adopt effective safeguards against diversion. The list coincides with items deemed "off limits" in the new decontrol system for the GDR. (C)
- The U.S. can present an illustrative core list proposal to move forward the development of such a list as the British have not provided additional details on their original proposal. (C)
