- Q: Why is the USG refusing to interfere to stop the bloodshed taking place in Liberia since the fall of the Doe regime?
- A: Since the Liberian crisis began, we have consistently stated that we will not deploy U.S. forces to Liberia to intervene in that country's internal conflict in any way. U.S. military forces have been tasked only with the requirement to protect the lives of U.S. citizens and evacuate them if they are threatened by the fighting. We look to neighboring African governments in ECOWAS and the OAU to continue their efforts to bring peace to Liberia. We continue to call on all persons in positions of authority or influence in Liberia to help bring the bloodshed to an end.

2. SUMMARY: TAYLOR TOLD US JULY 3 THAT IF DOE RESIGNED
TAYLOR WOULD ENSURE PROTECTION OF DOE'S FOLLOWERS AND

SPEAKER HILL TO FILL IN AS HEAD OF STATE DURING THE

COMMITMENT TO HUMANE TREATMENT OF ALL LIBERIANS, AND

-- EMBOFF: WE WANT TO CLARIFY A MESSAGE THAT WE SENT
THIS MORNING. DOE'S SPOKESMEN HAVE ASKED FOR
PROTECTION FOR DOE'S FOLLOWERS, NOT FOR DOE HIMSELF,
AS A CONDITION FOR HIS RESIGNATION. ARE YOU CLEAR ON
THAT DISTINCTION?

-- TAYLOR: THAT SOUNDS REASONABLE. CAN YOU GIVE ME
NAMES? I DON'T THINK WE HAVE ANY MAJOR OBJECTIONS TO
SOME OF THE FOLLOWERS.

-- EMBOFF: WE ARE TALKING ABOUT HUMANE TREATMENT OF
ALL DOE'S FOLLOWERS, INCLUDING KRAHN TROOPS.

-- TAYLOR: YES. KRAHN TROOPS ARE LIBERIANS, AND WE
HAVE NO PROBLEM WITH KRAHN TROOPS. ALSO, WE HAVE NO
PROBLEM WITH THE SPEAKER. WE CONSIDER HIM AN
INDIVIDUAL WHO COULD HOLD POWER IN THE GOVERNMENT
UNTIL WE GET INTO TOWN.

-- EMBOFF: I WANT TO MAKE SURE THAT YOU ARE ASSURING
PROTECTION FOR DOE'S FOLLOWERS, INCLUDING KRAHN TROOPS.

-- TAYLOR: THAT IS CORRECT. I'M SAYING THAT THEY ARE
LIBERIANS AND THAT WE OWE THEM PROTECTION UNDER THE
LAW. I AM SAYING TO YOU POSITIVELY AND EMPHATICALLY
THAT WE WILL GIVE THEM ALL NECESSARY PROTECTION.

-- EMBOFF: IF DOE ACCEPTS YOUR CONDITIONS AND RESIGNS
WHAT WOULD BE YOUR NEXT STEP?

-- TAYLOR: IF HE RESIGNS AT THIS PARTICULAR TIME WE DO
NOT WANT A VACUUM. THE SPEAKER CAN HOLD POWER FOR THE

NEXT FEW HOURS UNTIL WE GET INTO TOWN. WE WILL SET UP AN INTERIM GOVERNMENT AND SET UP PROTECTION AND WORK OUT THE DETAILS OF THE PROTECTION FOR HIS FOLLOWERS.

-- EMBOFF: WHO WOULD MAKE UP THAT INTERIM GOVERNMENT?

-- TAYLOR: I AM NOT IN A POSITION TO NAME MY GOVERNMENT OVER THE RADIO. THE GOVERNMENT WILL BE DECIDED BY THE NPFL.

-- EMBOFF: CAN YOU TELL ME IF THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT COULD INCLUDE MEMBERS OF THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT?

-- TAYLOR: IT IS IMPOSSIBLE AT THIS TIME TO ENGAGE IN SUCH CONJECTURE. INDIVIDUAL LIBERIANS WHO ARE ACCEPTABLE TO THE PEOPLE AND TO US WILL BE INCLUDED IN AN OFFICIAL GOVERNMENT.

SUBJECT: TFLI01: CONVERSATION WITH TAYLOR ON RESIGNS, WOULD YOU BE IN A POSITION TO CEASE HOSTILITIES?

-- TAYLOR: ALMOST IMMEDIATELY. IF DOE RESIGNS AND NAMES HIS SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES NOW TO HOLD OVER FOR THE NEXT FEW HOURS WE WILL CEASE HOSTILITIES AND SET UP AN INTERIM GOVERNMENT. I EVEN INTEND TO HAVE A SURPRISE ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE WORLD THAT WE INTEND TO STICK TO THE PROCESS OF FREE ELECTIONS AT THE SOONEST POSSIBLE TIME. WE WILL MAKE THAT ANNOUNCEMENT WHEN I GIVE A NATIONAL RADIO ADDRESS.

-- EMBOFF: DO YOU HAVE ANYTHING ELSE FOR US?

-- TAYLOR: YES, WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO A VERY QUICK AND IMMEDIATE RESPONSE FROM THE ADMINISTRATION. WE WANT A VERY CLOSE RELATIONSHIP, AND CAN ASSURE YOU AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE THAT WE INTEND TO USE THE BALLOT BOX FOR THE GOOD OF ALL, INCLUDING FULL POLITICAL PARTICIPATION BY PARTIES AND GROUPS IN THE COUNTRY.

-- EMBOFF: IN CLOSING, I WOULD LIKE TO REPEAT ONCE MORE OUR CONCERN FOR HUMANE TREATMENT OF ALL PEOPLE IN THE COUNTRY.

-- TAYLOR: I CAN ASSURE YOU THAT CONCERN IS ALSO MY CONCERN. THAT IS WHY WE HAVE PROCEEDED WITH CAUTION ALL THESE WEEKS. WE WILL CONTINUE TO RESPECT INTERNATIONAL LAW AND WILL ABIDE BY THE GENEVA CONVENTION.

4. TAYLOR ALSO SAID THAT HE HAD BEEN DELAYED IN MAKING CONTACT WITH US BECAUSE HIS RADIO HAD BLOWN A TRANSFORMER, AND THAT HE HAD HAD TO MOVE TO A DIFFERENT SITE. HE ASKED FOR HELP IN REPLACING THE TRANSFORMER TO FACILITATE COMMUNICATION WITH US. WE SAID WE WOULD LOOK INTO IT. WE DO NOT KNOW WHAT THE PRECISE NEED IS. REQUEST DEPARTMENT GUIDANCE AS TO WHETHER WE SHOULD PURSUE ISSUE FURTHER.

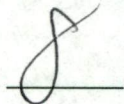

- Q: Why is the USG refusing to interfere to stop the bloodshed taking place in Liberia since the fall of the Doe regime?
- A: Since the Liberian crisis began, we have consistently stated that we will not deploy U.S. forces to Liberia to intervene in that country's internal conflict in any way. U.S. military forces have been tasked only with the requirement to protect the lives of U.S. citizens and evacuate them if they are threatened by the fighting. We look to neighboring African governments in ECOWAS and the OAU to continue their efforts to bring peace to Liberia. We continue to call on all persons in positions of authority or influence in Liberia to help bring the bloodshed to an end.
