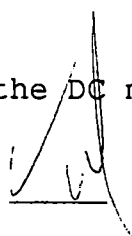

1. Intelligence Update: There is a report that Iraq has seized the U.S. crew of a U.S. flag tanker. ^{1.4(c); 3.3(b)(1)}

[REDACTED] The tenth armor divisions was at the railhead at As Jubair. The 5th mech division is moving from Fish Lake along with the third armor division. This represents the best four divisions in the Iraqi army. (S)

Units in Kuwait have not been consolidated yet for further offensive action. According to Saudi Ambassador Prince Bandar, there is a new announcement from the Turks that they won't close the pipeline. The Kuwaiti Ambassador called to find out about a report from the Saudi Crown Prince that there was an assassination attempt against Saddam. We have nothing on that. (S)

2. Diplomatic Update: The Kuwaiti Ambassador reported that the Amir appreciated the President's letter to him. The Amir said that Kuwait is totally committed financially to repaying the Turks for loses from the pipeline closure. Turkish President Ozal is calling the Amir in Saudi Arabia. The Amir wants to talk to the President before he talks to Ozal about the pipeline. (S)

We have a message from Egyptian President Mubarak asking that we not intervene militarily. The Kuwaiti Ambassador noted that we have made our red line at the Saudi border, and that we have publicized the President's message. We have the results of the EC meeting, and we should call Italian Prime Minister Andreotti. (S)
