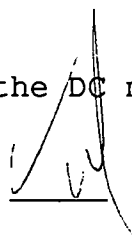
SUBJECT: Minutes for DC Meetings on the Gulf Crisis from

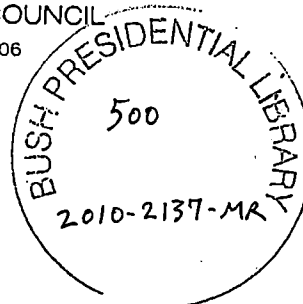

Minutes

1. UN Impasse. We are having trouble getting agreement on language "such minimal force as may be necessary" and "under the authority of the Security Council". The UN Security Council should have political vice operational control. At 9:00 a.m. our time an Iraqi tanker will be in Yemen waters. The Security Council is meeting tonight. We could live with "the Military Staff Committee will coordinate as appropriate..." (S)

On port access for intercept operations, we need to approach host governments. On the Iraqi tanker heading south in the Red Sea, the French should be asked to intercept it by the U.S. Navy. (S)

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2. ^{14(d)} [REDACTED] (S)

3. **Intelligence Update:** There have been some Iraqi troop rotations. A mech division has replaced an armor division, and an armor division has replaced an infantry division. Two IL-76s from Libya are in Iraq. Some MIG23s are being prepared for air to air refueling conversion. (S)

On the detainees, Iraqi troops are moving house to house through Baghdad. U.S. citizens are being held in various places in Baghdad. OPEC meeting is not getting yet. (S)

4. **Tightening Sanctions:** ^{14(d)} [REDACTED] (S)

5. **Air Interception:** Nothing to report. (S)

6. **Ivry Visit:** We should discuss red lines. The JSAP will provide cover for the visit. We need to see the non-JSAP talking points. (S)

7. **Saudi Arms Sales:** At Secretary Cheney's suggestion, the President has agreed with a two-step approach. We would go ahead with 24 aircraft, the M60A3s, and the DU ammo first. Stinger and 24 more aircraft could be considered later. (S)

8. **Americans in Kuwait and Iraq:** The idea of closure of Embassy Kuwait is null and void. It is linked with UNSC resolution 662 and with the safe departure of Americans from Kuwait. State should send out a cable on our position. (S)

9. **Jordan Compensation Paper:** State is to do components of a strategy. It should include: how much Jordan needs, what we want from the GOJ, who to approach, how to approach them, how much money and oil to request, getting security assurances. (S)

10. **Interagency Compensation Group:** The EB group should put together a donors consortium for Egypt and Turkey; could include Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Germany and Japan. Jean McAllister should take the lead. (S)

11. **Turkey:** The 401st wants intelligence and a full exchange on Iraq. The 401st made no specific request. The military exercise was cancelled. (S)

12. **Congress:** CIA should do consultations for Senator Dole and Congressman Foley. Senator Pell should get a briefing. (S)

13. Egypt should be asked to send mechanized and armored divisions. (S)

14. According to a message from our Charge' in Baghdad, Tariq Aziz, the Iraqi Foreign Minister, has said he is ready to talk if Washington wants to. (S)

15. **Eight Point Peace Plan**

16. A Washington Times story reports that the Soviets are still providing assistance to Iraq. (S)
