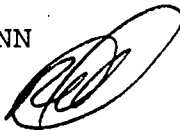

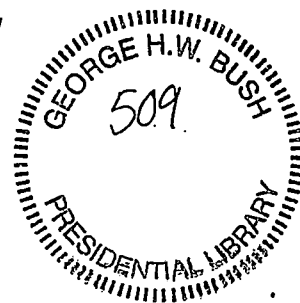

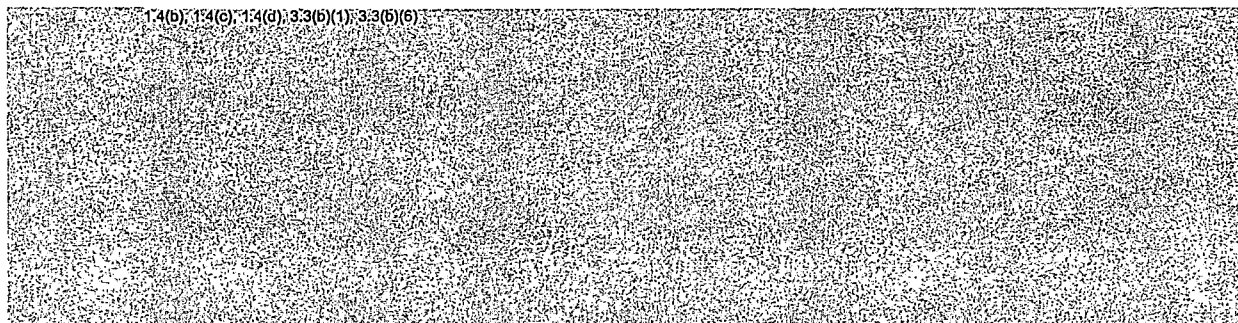

Minutes

1. Intelligence Update: Tanks and artillery are visible around the British and American Embassies in Kuwait. Power and water have been cut. (S)



2. UNSC Update: There has been a call from 3.3(b)(1) 3.3(b)(6) on sanctions. (S)

-- There has been a breakthrough. Ambassador Pickering, the British and French have reached a common position on the Soviet language changes. It allows the use of minimal force. At 6:00 pm the UN Security Council will meet informally to consider the revised resolution. (S)

-- A clarification on 3.3(b)(6) message from Saddam, families includes releasing wives and children of foreigners not just diplomats. (S)

3. Intercept Operations: The UAE is stalling on a response on divert ports. Bahrain wants a diplomatic note. Riyadh wants to discuss this as part of an action plan with Secretary Cheney. We need to get back to the Egyptians. Larry Eagleburger is meeting with Ambassador El Reedy. (S)

4. Retaliation Measures: A cable was sent out and the Ambassadors here were called in. (S)

5. Sanctions Breakers: Ambassadors should be called in. Presidential messages should be sent. Gene McAllister's group is doing an Iraqi sanctions action items paper. (S)

Larry Eagleburger is meeting with the Yugoslavian Foreign Minister on sanctions violations. As leverage there should be a watch list of violators issued by the UN Sanctions Committee. (S)

6. Public Diplomacy: We need to be tying it all together in an

There was general endorsement for the emergency package for Saudi Arabia, including the F15Cs and Ds. F-15Es will be a problem, as will Stingers after the conflict. (S)
8. Asylum for Iraqi Ship Captains: Look at the issue of quarantine from INS restrictions. (S)
9. B-52s in Saudi Arabia: Request under consideration. (S)
