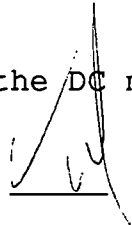
SUBJECT: Minutes for DC Meetings on the Gulf Crisis from

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5. The Gur Mariner is returning to the UK. It may be carrying biological warfare cultures. (S)
6. On air interdiction, there are not many planes going into Baghdad. We should still get a cable out reminding people not to bust sanctions using airlift. (S)
7. On Jordan, we need to do more on refugees. The visuals are awful. There is \$20 million in military assistance funds for Jordan still uncommitted. We need to see if there are any unexpended refugee funds that can be used here. (S)
8. The UN Sanctions Committee will define humanitarian assistance in terms of food, medicine for Iraq. (S)
9. SCUD launchers are being developed by Iraq. (S)
10. Iraq has defined its new province by drawing a line north of Kuwait City inside Kuwait. Iraqis are sending virtually everything back to Iraq from Kuwait. (S)
11. Kuwaiti air force A-4 parts are moving. (S)
12. On public diplomacy, USIA efforts in the area are inadequate. There is a lot of broadcasting in the region, including by religious figures. USIA needs to do more in the area. (S)
