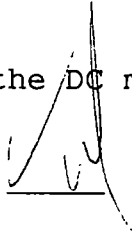
SUBJECT: Minutes for DC Meetings on the Gulf Crisis from

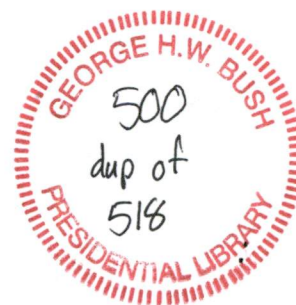

1. We now have American citizen Worthington's body. We need to know more about what happened to Miles Hoffmann. (S)
2. There are reports of Egyptian workers being killed in Iraq, and of Americans being shot and their legs broken in Kuwait. (S)
3. Everything is on track for the multinational naval conference in Bahrain. (S)

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4. We made a demarche Friday to the Swiss that was passed to Iran on Saturday about the three Iraqi tankers. Iran has said they will not be allowed in its territorial waters or they will be stopped. They noted that there is no authority for Iraq or other foreign vessels to enter their territorial waters. At least one or more of the tankers got to Iraq by going within seven nautical miles of Iran. (S)

5. There is an Iraqi tanker bound for Cuba. There is a question about whether to seize the ships or let them pass if they don't have any cargo. (S)

6. The world community and the United States have stepped up to the humanitarian assistance needs of the refugees. (S)

7. The President's message to the Iraqi people will be from the world community. It will note Arab/Arab violence. It will also include the Saddam quote "feeding the army first". (S)

8. Chapman Cox, President of the USO, is trying to arrange airlift. (S)

9. On stopping the Iraqi ship bound for Cuba, Iraqi ships should be considered as Iraqi assets for consideration as reparations. (S)

12. For President Ozal's visit, we need to determine what we want to do with Turkey. A PCC will be held to discuss this on Tuesday. (S)

13. The Soviets have said their advisors will remain in Iraq until their contracts end. (S)

14. When the President makes his remarks to the Iraqi people, the Iraqis are planning to round up about 2 million people to demonstrate against them. (S)

15. Egypt will send its third mechanized division to King Khalid Military City via Yanbu. Food and fuel will be provided by the Saudi government; ammunition by Egypt; and spare parts by the United States. (S)
