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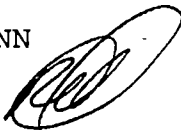

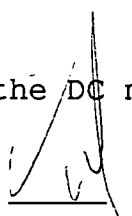
SUBJECT: Minutes for DC Meetings on the Gulf Crisis from

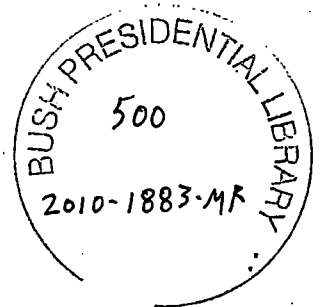

1. Intelligence Update:

14(C), 14(D), (b)(3)

There have been no major changes in the disposition of Iraqi forces in Kuwait. They are maintaining defensive lines in Kuwait. (S)

-- Saddam's statement was tough on getting foreign forces out of the region in an effort to split the western coalition with regard to Mitterand's proposal. (S)

-- There has been no activity in the west at missiles sites or Taji. (S)

-- A provocation by Iraq could result in a preemptive move by Israel and that would split the Arabs. What would we do? (S)

2. UN Update: We need to consider next steps on another resolution on human rights abuses. There was a Newsweek story about Article 42. The NAM believes that UN diplomacy is moving too fast in order to prove diplomacy won't work so that we can move to use of force. (S)

-- The UN is considering sanctions against sanctions violators. (S)

-- State should develop a paper on next steps in the United Nations. (S)

3. Counselor Update: In Kuwait there are 330 civilians with 19 in the Embassy and 8 diplomats. In Iraq, there are 350 civilians including 23 in the Ambassador's residence and 150 that were rounded up by Iraq. In addition there are 7 diplomats and 51 people from Embassy Kuwait. (S)

4. The 40,000 Indian hostages will be out by October 12. Their food will be distributed to other Asians. There has been a slowdown on the Sri Lankan boat until we see what happens to the Indian food. The PLO have made a request for food for 400,000 Palestinians which should be denied. (S)

6. On the war crimes paper, clearances should be sent to State. (S)
