John Tuck called to say that, while he understood from the November 13 meeting that both the general policy and the Brazilian and Indian cases had been approved on November 8, Henson Moore believed that only the general policy (i.e. not the cases) had been approved. The DOE position seems to be shaping up to a recommendation to disapprove the licenses to Brazil and India on the grounds of their poor track record in nonproliferation matters.

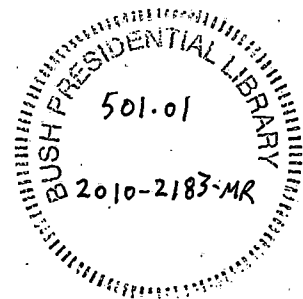

Summary of Conclusions

It was agreed that:

- Failure to adhere to the Non-Proliferation Treaty, to adopt full-scope safeguards, or to accept other formal nonproliferation commitments should not of itself create a presumption of denial of an export license application for a high-speed computer. (S)
- A presumption against approval should exist for export license applications for high-speed computers when the recipient country is not an NPT party and is developing nuclear weapons or missile technologies and/or has transferred such technologies to third parties. The USG should seek multilateral cooperation for this approach. (S)
- The President should retain the option to approve or disapprove proposed high-speed computer exports based on overriding foreign policy or national security considerations. (S)
- Depending on the circumstances, intrusive safeguards can contribute to our confidence of deterring misuse of high-speed computers. (OMB did not concur in this view.) (S)
- The export license application for an IBM upgrade to Embraer in Brazil should be approved under the following conditions:
 - Brazil should waive into force the Treaty of Tlatelolco, or accept full-scope safeguards over its nuclear activities;
 - Brazil should accept intrusive computer safeguards, including both static and random sampling;
 - The Government of Brazil should provide assurances that it will not permit assistance in the development of nuclear weapons, ballistic missiles, or other weapons of mass destruction to be provided to Iraq or other nations; and
 - Future license applications for high-speed computers will be denied if the USG receives credible information that Brazil has violated the foregoing assurance. (S)

- The conditions attached by the USG to the Embraer export will be conveyed to the Government of Brazil in a way that would not defeat the objectives we seek to promote. (S)
- The export license applications for a Cray computer to the Indian Institute of Science at Bangalore should be approved, provided that India accepts intrusive computer safeguards, including both static and random sampling. (S)
- The decision to require random sampling in the Brazilian and Indian cases shall not constitute a precedent; conditions to be applied to future exports will be decided on a case-by-case basis. (S)
