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Minutes

Mr. Gates: I would like to start by reviewing the status of the actions taken under the Memorandum of Disapproval, then I'd like to address the question of legislative strategy. We need aggressively to take the initiative here. If we had had the Executive Order in the Spring or Summer of last year, we may not have had this problem today. Therefore, the same passive approach would be a mistake. It would just be to wait for the Congress to jam bad legislation down the President's throat. You can't beat something with nothing. (Ø)

First, I'd like to review the actions taken under the Memorandum of Disapproval. You all have that paper. Are there any comments? (Ø)

Ambassador Bartholomew: I think it is going rather well. (U)

Mr. Hadley: I have a technical point. I would like to make sure that we are taking the suppliers approach, not the COCOM approach. (Ø)

Ambassador Bartholomew: There is one matter: the distribution licenses for free world distribution. We are waiting for the circulation of the reg. (Ø)

Mr. Kloske: It was circulated this morning. (U)

Mr. Hadley: On supercomputers, my impression is that we are building on our relationship with Japan, not requiring coordination with all COCOM partners. (Ø)

Mr. Kloske: On supercomputers, there is a three-tier approach; among suppliers, then among all COCOM members and, finally, everybody else. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: Let's turn to the legislative question. Our Congressional folks expect us to face the same legislation that the President vetoed last November, which now may be passed with a veto-proof majority. (Ø)

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Let me just throw out a proposed game plan and then get your reaction:

- I propose that Brent write to several key Senators -- Garn, Dole, and Heinz -- as well as to Fawcett, to try to generate Congressional support for the Administration's legislation. (X)
- Then we draft separate CBW and EAA legislation. This group would meet around January 15 here, so we can get that legislation introduced early. (X)
- On CBW, we try to get the House version and the Executive Order together. We must be careful not to imply that our Executive Order is inadequate, while remaining open to suggestions for improved legislative authority. The PCC on Nonproliferation can handle this. (X)
- On the EAA legislation, I suggest that the PCC on Technology Transfer manage the drafting of a bill with the following elements: (1) stripping the current legislation of the micromanagement of the Executive Branch, and (2) reconfigure the current legislation to eliminate the artificial split between foreign policy and national security controls, recognizing that nonproliferation is a subset of national security. (X)

Ambassador Bartholomew: Our people say that the CBW legislation on the Hill is on the fast track, so I think we need something sooner than January 15. In fact, I think we need that soon after January 3rd. It is OK to put EAA on a slightly slower track. Second, I agree with the Scowcroft letter but I would urge that Scowcroft call them over here. I would try to do that before the 3rd of January. (X)

Mr. Gates: It will be hard to do that before January 3, but we could add to the letter to the Senators a statement saying, "Come in and see me the first week you are back." (X)

Ambassador Bartholomew: I think we should make the new proposal as much like the vetoed bill as possible, make it tougher where possible, and preserve the essential elements to the President by way of discretion. (X)

Mr. Gates: I think we need a half-dozen dynamite problems that the vetoed legislation would have caused -- where we can show things so blatantly absurd that they have a hard time defending their proposal on the Hill. (X)

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Ambassador Bartholomew: On EAA, yes...strip the micro-management. But we are not ready to sign on to merging nonproliferation controls with other controls. We need to study that question. (Ø)

We need to take the initiative with Pell, Broomfield, Sarbanes. It is particularly important for the Department of Commerce and the Department of Defense to be active and vigorous in pressing this bill, as well, because they were the ones that recommended that the President not veto the EAA. If there is any indication of a reluctant good soldier, carrying out the wishes of the NSC and State, then we will all lose. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: There is a remarkably good record in this Administration for supporting the President and closing ranks after a decision has been made. (Ø)

Ambassador Bartholomew: I meant that we need to move forward with vigor. (U)

The need for industrial support is critical, and I would propose that several actions be coordinated out of the White House:

- The implementation of the six actions from the Memorandum of Disapproval, especially the license-free COCOM exports and new regimes for supercomputers. (Ø)
- The results of the Core List exercise in telecommunications and computers, which reflect the sensitivity to what we have been hearing from industry. (Ø)
- Also, we need high-level contacts with major companies -- like IBM, AT&T, and others -- to work with us. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: Steve? (U)

Mr. Hadley: It seems to me you've got the right strategy. We will give it full support. (U)

General Graves: I support it. It makes sense to fold foreign policy considerations into national security controls. The two groups are working the same issue. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: Dennis? (U)

Mr. Kloske: Sure, we support all of this in principle. It would be useful to have guidance from you on what the legislation should contain. There is no way just to reopen all issues. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: As a theoretical matter, that's probably true. The practical way to manage it is for the PCC to take a whack at this, and not get wrapped around the axle. If a real problem or problems emerge, let's get right back here and get any of these issues settled within a day or two. (Ø)

I agree with Reg...maybe this group should meet around the 5th of January on CBW and wait until January 15 on EAA. (Ø)

Mr. Kloske: Our ability to garner industry support is tempered by the fact that we just imposed a batch of unilateral controls upon them. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: Read? (U)

Ambassador Hanmer: Sounds good. (U)

Mr. Card: Yes. (U)

Mr. Diefenderfer: Yes, and that letter to the key Senators should go out tomorrow. (Ø)

Mr. Kloske: I should point out that Sarbanes is really pissed off. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: Let's see if we can call Sarbanes tomorrow. Henson? (Ø)

Mr. Moore: We agree. (U)

Mr. Gates: Try and get your comments on the letters to the key Senators in to us by COB today. Dick? (Ø)

Mr. Kerr: Nothing on this one. (U)

Mr. Diefenderfer: You had better wind in the Republican House leadership -- Michel and Gingrich, if you can -- into this process. (Ø)

Mr. Kloske: Don't leave out Gejdenson. (Ø)

Mr. Diefenderfer: You should get McClure's shop up to speed on this. (Ø)

Mr. Hadley: I second Dennis on the Gejdenson point. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: We will check with our legislative people to see if there is any reason not to write to Gejdenson. (Ø)

Ambassador Bartholomew: We need some clarification on the supercomputer decision, particularly as it relates to the PRC. (Ø)

We take it that this Presidential decision does not mandate a flat policy of denial on MTCR grounds. We take it that each case takes all national security grounds into account. There is one complication; we don't have the right to deny these kinds of exports, under COCOM, on MTCR grounds. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: My impression and recollection from the meetings was that there was unanimous consent in this group that the approval of the two computers included conditionality on the observance of the MTCR guidelines. My suggestion is that the PCC look at it, and if there is a problem, it should come back to us with a recommended fix. (Ø)

Ambassador Bartholomew: I want to clarify also that this policy is addressed to high-speed computers, not all computers, and I suggest that the PCC define where the line between those two categories should be drawn. (Ø)

Mr. Gates: My sense is that this policy is to be applied only to high-speed computers. (Ø)

One more issue: I would like to propose that we have a last minute calibration on where we want to go on COCOM, perhaps sometimes in January. (Ø)

Mr. Hadley: Gejdenson is having hearings on January 24. (U)

Mr. Gates: OK. (U)

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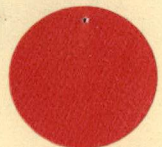

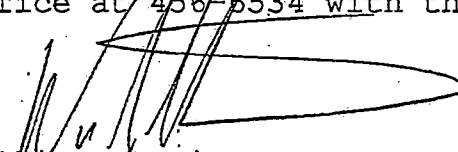
