Summary of Conclusions

It was agreed that:

- Subject to concurrence of Principals, the USG would issue war risk insurance to U.S. carriers serving the Middle East. Insurance coverage would be provided up to the effective date of an expected Notice to Airmen (NOTAM). This means that the Department of Transportation would issue policies up to midnight on January 14. (✓)
- The insurance policies could be cancelled on three days' notice or on shorter notice on safety grounds, e.g., in the event we receive intelligence reports of possible terrorist activity. (✓)
- State should review the list of countries for which such insurance is provided. Yemen and Iraq, for example, should be dropped from the list. (✓)
- The possible issuance of a NOTAM should be kept confidential for the present time. (✓)
