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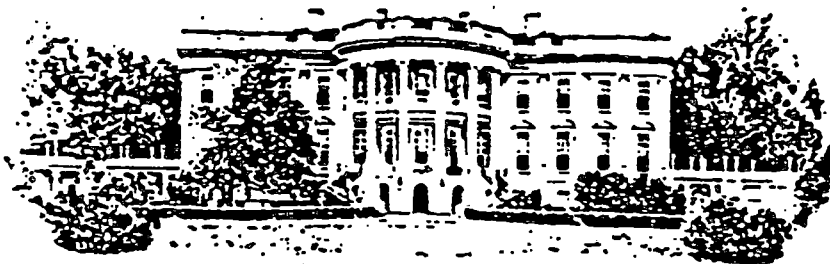

EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Haiti: Prospects for Aristide's Restoration

- The relative calm of the last few weeks is unlikely to hold as economic deterioration aggravates the acute polarization of Haitian society.
- Fuel supplies are expected to run out by the end of October. Resulting energy, transportation, and food shortages will touch off more violence and looting that substantially will increase the danger to US citizens.
- As economic activity plunges, regime leaders will be increasingly inclined to negotiate Aristide's conditioned return. We are concerned, however, that the rebel soldiers who still dominate the military will not agree to negotiate until extreme violence occurs.
- An agreement restoring Aristide to office could probably succeed if his authority were strictly limited, international aid were conditioned on his observance of democratic and human rights, and an international peacekeeping presence were established in Haiti.

This Executive Brief was requested by William Pryce, Senior Director for Latin American Affairs, National Security Council. It presents the findings of Intelligence Community representatives at a teleconference held on 22 October 1991. It was produced by the National Intelligence Officer for Latin America and was coordinated with representatives of CIA, State/INR, DLA, NSA, and the Services.

Haiti's relative calm is unlikely to hold much longer. Polarization is increasing between the monied, literate backers of Prime Minister Honorat's regime and the majority of the populace who feel no allegiance to it.

Honorat's Tenuous Grip

Supporting the de facto regime are the business elite, elements of the middle class, politicians of almost every stripe, and the armed forces. This coalition has put aside political differences and is united by fear of what Aristide would do if he returned. In particular, Embassy reporting indicates that the enlisted men and noncommissioned officers who carried out the coup--and apparently most of their peers--remain firm in insisting that Aristide not return.

Thus far, only scattered and limited violence has been directed at the regime. Most pro-Aristide leaders and members of his radical Lavalas movement remain in hiding, although Embassy reporting indicates that Lavalas activists have initiated clandestine radio broadcasting. Some violence directed against the military by Aristide supporters has occurred, and armed opposition apparently is being organized. The military recently raided a home being used as a base of operations by several well-armed civilians.

Sanctions Take Hold

The viability of the Honorat regime will erode substantially over the next two

weeks as international sanctions begin to bite deeply. Some measures--the cutoff of Venezuelan fuel shipments, termination of foreign aid from nearly all sources, and the freezing of Haitian assets in the United States and Panama, for example, are already having a major impact.

- Severe shortages of fuel are evident in the countryside, and several towns already are without electricity and gasoline.
- Food prices are rising; the faulty food distribution system (increasingly impaired by fuel shortages) is causing some local scarcities.

Fuel in Port-au-Prince is likely to run out by the end of October. Even if the regime conserves fuel, reserves will be depleted in early November. Once fuel runs out, economic decline will be rapid.

- Port-au-Prince will be without power and no public transportation will be available.
- Poverty and unemployment will worsen as factories shut down.
- Food supply and distribution problems will become severe, and inflation will surge.

If international sanctions are tightened even further and US and most other trade with Haiti is cut off, food supplies would be most severely affected. Although some food would be transported across the border with the Dominican Republic, severe shortages of basic foodstuffs would

quickly occur in many areas, especially in the capital.

Even in the absence of a full trade embargo, however, fuel shortages could cause political stability and the overall security situation to break down soon.

Prospects for Violence

The Intelligence Community expects an increase in looting and extortion by the military and others with weapons. Riots and unrest in Port-au-Prince and other urban areas also are likely. We believe that elites and supporters of the provisional government, including military personnel, will be attacked by individuals and by mobs.

Furthermore, Aristide's supporters in the Lavalas movement are likely to try to exploit a breakdown in public order to foment more active resistance to the military and the Honorat regime.

Under such circumstances, the military is unlikely to have the firepower, mobility, or command and control discipline to handle the situation.

Disposition to Negotiate

We believe there is still room and time--albeit diminishing--for a negotiated settlement. The key to a possible resolution, however, will be the ability of Haitian elites to convince rebel soldiers--fearful of reprisals--to agree to Aristide's return.

The Honorat regime and the Haitian legislature have left open a window for negotiations.

- Honorat announced in mid-October that he has 45 days to negotiate Aristide's return before he must call new elections.
- Regime officials and Armed Forces Commander Raoul Cedras have privately told US diplomats they are willing in principle to negotiate Aristide's return.
- The parliamentary delegates in Washington on 21 October for discussions with OAS officials did not rule out Aristide's return, although they were most interested in cataloguing his abuses of the constitution.

At the moment, these indicators probably reflect maneuvering to avert more severe international sanctions rather than actual willingness to restore Aristide.

As the economy deteriorates, government leaders and Haitian elites will be more inclined to negotiate a highly conditioned return of President Aristide. They are likely to seek a settlement that tightly limits his power and invests the Prime Minister, his cabinet, and the legislature with substantial authority as the constitution provides. They probably would also demand that an international presence be maintained in Haiti to guarantee an accord.

At present, however political, business, and military elites are not concerned

enough to try to persuade the soldiers to negotiate. We believe the odds are high the rebel troops will not agree to negotiations before the country lurches into anarchy.

If Aristide Were Restored

In order to regain power, Aristide probably would consent to conditions limiting his authority as long as he did not view them as humiliating.

He already has displayed some flexibility on the terms of his restoration, albeit only under pressure from the international community. For example, he has foresworn political violence, pledged to respect the constitution, and agreed to accept the legislature's selection of a new Prime Minister.

Over the longer run, he probably again would seek to exercise power autocratically and arbitrarily by employing violence against his real and imagined opponents, justifying his actions as carrying out the will of the people. A semblance of political stability probably can be restored if some combination of the following conditions applied over a protracted period to restrain Aristide's mercurial behavior:

- A solid two-thirds bloc of the legislature were immune to intimidation by Aristide and his supporters and were prepared to impeach him if he disregarded the constitution.
- An OAS or other international peacekeeping presence were established in Haiti to help minimize violence and the chances of another coup.
- International economic aid to Haiti were conditioned on Aristide's respecting democracy and human rights.

Implications for the United States

US citizens have not been specifically targetted or harassed, but as conditions in Haiti deteriorate, the United States increasingly will be blamed for the hardships, and Americans will be in greater danger.

Intelligence Community analysts agree with Ambassador Adams' assessment that if violence becomes widespread--as is likely--US citizens could be attacked by Aristide supporters, elements of the military, or both.

Either side might view international military intervention--provoked by attacks on Americans--as favorable to their interests, whether to reinstate Aristide, to prevent that outcome, or to restore stability.

The decline of the economy and attendant social chaos also could lead to a substantial increase in the number of Haitians seeking to reach the United States by boat.

SUBJECT: Haiti Crisis (U)

(S) The breakdown of constitutional order in Haiti and the banishment of its democratically elected president, J. Bertrand Aristide, represents a setback for democracy in Latin America and the Caribbean. Fortunately, we have witnessed unprecedented action by the Organization of American States (OAS) to solve this crisis through diplomatic means. We view the OAS's assertive role as a positive development and have wholeheartedly endorsed its actions to date.

(S) Through the Latin America PCC process, we in DoD have supported the formulation and execution of USG policy on Haiti and the OAS. While the PCC has functioned well during this crisis, we believe that further substantive decisions should be raised to the Deputies' Committee for resolution--particularly with regard to U.S. implementation of further sanctions. We are concerned that some of the actions being proposed will further destabilize the situation, perhaps leading to circumstances where U.S. military intervention is contemplated. That is a situation which we wish to avoid.

(S) I recommend that we convene a DC meeting to discuss these matters.

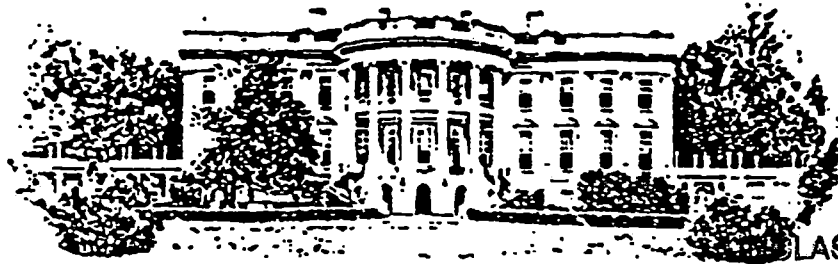

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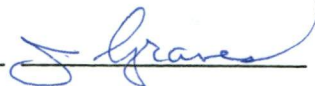
