Minutes

General Scowcroft: We have a real mess on our hands. Let's get the legal status first. (U)

Mr. Levin: There will be a hearing next Monday at 7:00 p.m. The Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) could be turned into a permanent injunction then. We could get a decision Tuesday but it is not guaranteed by then. We cannot appeal a permanent injunction but we can keep appealing the TRO. We think we can win in the 11th Circuit court. We have strong legal arguments. It could happen in 7-10 days; that is the optimistic view. The pessimistic view is that it would slide another week. The discovery is beginning now. They will be ready to do it on board

the cutters beginning Saturday. NBC news will accompany the plaintiffs lawyers. We have tried everything to avoid the press and to advance the hearing. The decision allows the judge to do anything he wants for 20 days. We expect bad PR but not necessarily bad news for legal arguments. (C)

Secretary Skinner: We need to figure out where we can offload the Haitians. (C)

Secretary Eagleburger: Is Puerto Rican territory considered the US? (C)

Mr. Rees: Yes. (U)

Secretary Skinner: The only place we can offload and not complicate jurisdiction is Guantanamo. ()

Mr. Levin: If we offload at other than Guantanamo -- that is, on US territory -- they get asylum claim rights and we have them for about two years. ()

Secretary Skinner: What happens to them? (U)

Mr. Levin: They can be released from detention but we cannot return them to Haiti. (C)

Mr. Rees: There is no detention space. (C)

Mr. Levin: We would have to build more detention space. (C)

General Scowcroft: What would it take to have legislation to send them back sooner -- when the situation in Haiti improves? (C)

Mr. Levin: Yes, we have been trying but so far have been unsuccessful. (C)

Mr. Skinner: What about the discovery? (U)

Mr. Levin: The document discovery will be more embarrassing than it will be a legal problem. Discovery of documents and depositions can turn up something embarrassing. (C)

Secretary Eagleburger: What about not picking them up? (C)

Secretary Skinner: We have an obligation to do it. (C)

Admiral Kime: Guidance is to pick up people on unseaworthy boats. (C)

Secretary Eagleburger: This judge has decided? (C)

Mr. Levin: Yes, we cannot win anything with him. The plaintiffs could have gotten more if they had asked. They want to speak

with Haitians re what to say -- to coach them. They want expanded interviews and to have them done off the cutters. Expansion would be pretty much what we were doing anyway before these huge numbers. The post-interview review would take place for everyone. (C)

Secretary Skinner: Interview who? (C)

Mr. Levin: All. (U)

Secretary Skinner: Timing? (U)

Mr. Levin: After the 20th day the judge has to move. (U)

Secretary Skinner: Is it possible that a class action suit could come in? Is there a case right on point in the 11th Circuit? (U)

Mr. Levin: No. There is one in South Florida and one in the DC Circuit court. (U)

Secretary Skinner: Has any circuit court ruled against us? (U)

Mr. Levin: None.. (U)

Secretary Skinner: Any with us? (U)

Mr. Rees: One. It is in the TRO stage -- the judge said, "I'll think about it." (U)

Secretary Skinner: Has this judge done other migrant cases like this? (U)

Mr. Levin: No. We anticipate we will lose with him and everyone should be prepared for that. (C)

Secretary Skinner: We are assuming we can repatriate after a successful legal case. The numbers are growing. We picked up 439 Friday, 383 Saturday, 815 Sunday, and now we are alongside 200 more. (U)

Admiral Jeremiah: The total is almost 5,000 now. (U)

Admiral Kime: 4530 now plus the 200. The government is encouraging them to leave on boats. (C)

Mr. Levin: There is a reasonable possibility we will win in the 11th Circuit Court. There is a better than 50/50 chance. (C)

Secretary Eagleburger: If we lose there, then what? ()

Mr. Levin: The Supreme Court. It is 50/50 we will win this one even if we have to go to the Supreme Court. ()

Admiral Jeremiah: We authorized Admiral Ebney (CINCPAC) to take 2500 more at Guantanamo. That gets us to Thursday. (C)

Admiral Kime: That will allow us to offload some of the Haitians before discovery. (C)

Mr. Ford: A tent city will be a magnet. (C)

Secretary Eagleburger: Less so than Miami. (C)

Secretary Skinner: Can we do a tent city without the people in Haiti knowing? (C)

Several: No. (U)

Secretary Eagleburger: If we assume the right answer from the court, you have only a one-two-three-week problem. (U)

Secretary Skinner: We need a message into Haiti regarding our intention to appeal the case and return the people to Haiti as soon as possible. (U)

Secretary Skinner: We should find every way of getting the message into Haiti. (U)

Mr. Kopp: Aristide did a Voice of America message asking people to stay home. (U)

Secretary Eagleburger: Does VOA get in? How about broadcasting every 30 minutes? (U)

Mr. Kopp: VOA broadcasts four times a day in Creole. (U)

Secretary Skinner: Do we know they can hear? (U)

Admiral Jeremiah: No electricity, no batteries - there is an embargo going on. (U)

Ambassador Lyman: They get mixed signals because they hear other media too. (U)

Secretary Skinner: Once the Haitians are on land anywhere, the numbers will increase hugely. (U)

Secretary Eagleburger: We have the idea of finding an island and making a fairly large refugee camp. We need to decide, and the President would have to call. I can't predict how long it would take to do this. There are question of water, etc. We need to decide today. Put as many in Guantanamo as possible. Try to do it before the interviews. (To Justice) It seems to me it is screwy to negotiate with the plaintiffs. The things they demand will set precedents that we will never get out from under. The bottom line is to return the Haitians to Haiti, and anything we do between now and then is humanitarian and aimed at slowing the

flow. This is a humanitarian policy not a racist one. We need to be hard as hell. Get a decision as soon as possible. Everything that compromises in between is a problem. (C)

Secretary Skinner: Why negotiate with the plaintiffs? (C)

Mr. Levin: We were exploring all options. I agree personally with the points made here. (C)

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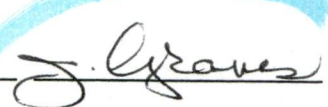
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
