SUBJECT: Deputies Committee Meeting on NSR-29,
Monday, February 10, 11:00 a.m.

At Tab A is the full package, modified per your instructions, provided to the Deputies. The first two items on the agenda are fairly straightforward, but no telling what comments we might get.

For the "next steps" discussion, I suggest you propose we (1) make the necessary changes to the priorities, (2) expand the summary with a little more elaboration (a sample is at Tab B) and (3) prepare a memorandum to be signed by the President to endorse the requirements (a draft is at Tab C). Depending on the outcome of the meeting, it may still be possible to meet the February 15 suspense if we forego an NSC meeting.

With respect to the Presidential memorandum, we should consider whether to submit it to full interagency coordination or to make it pretty much a Presidential perspective.
