We have concluded that the growing human tragedy in Bosnia cannot be accepted and that we should do what can to see the UN relief initiative succeed. Because of the conflict and chaos in Bosnia, success will not come easily or without risk. But we are better off helping the UN develop and execute a sound plan, than having to face a choice between inaction and an even more hazardous operation if the UN plan aborts or fails.

We do not yet know whether the UN initiative can be made feasible and acceptably safe, and we therefore do not want to raise international or public expectations. However, we should begin carefully conditioning domestic and international opinion to the fact that we are actively considering how to support the UN's demand for access to prevent large-scale starvation in Bosnia. Awareness that the U.S. is engaged may help convince the Serbs to cooperate.

This will be a UN operation with broad international involvement and support. We do not intend to dominate it or run the greatest risks. We will use NATO where possible -- for consulting with allies, meeting special needs, calling on allies to provide support, and possibly coordinating some operational aspects. However, we will not make this a NATO operation, allow it to get bogged down by NATO machinery or theology, or inhibit non-NATO participation (e.g., Russia, Saudi Arabia).

Last and most important, our aim is to help the UN carry out this mission in a non-hostile environment. While we will have to review the resources and rules of engagement needed for self-protection, we want to avoid hostilities.

The UN Plan

Once the parties to the Bosnian conflict agree to preconditions that will permit the Sarajevo airport to be secured, the UN will deploy roughly 1000 Canadians, and then re-open the airport for relief flights. The UN plan has serious gaps and defects, for example: an unspecified plan for ICRC and UNHCR ground distribution; inattention to airport condition and operation; lack of provision for reconnaissance; failure to anticipate refugee behavior. We will work directly and urgently with the UN to address these deficiencies.

There is even a doubt as to whether an airlift is the preferred way to mount and maintain a large relief operation for Sarajevo. The fact that the Canadian battalion intends to reach Sarajevo over-land from Croatia begs the question why not use the same route to bring through the actual supplies. (It may prove impossible for the Canadians to travel safely over-land.) Moreover, neither the UN nor we have adequately explored whether relief of large concentrations of deprived refugees elsewhere in

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Bosnia might be significantly easier and safer than a Sarajevo operation.

U.S. Support

To succeed, the UN will require US support in numerous categories: intelligence, helos, engineers, ordnance disposal, airport and air traffic management, airlift, refueling, counter-battery radar. It may be necessary to put from 30 to several hundred Americans on the ground (though this will at most be only a fraction of the total international presence). The UN can and should get others to contribute (e.g., vehicles, helos, supplies), and we can solicit and coordinate allied contributions through NATO.

The most urgent UN need is for planning and intelligence. Accordingly, we will send a EUCOM planning cell to Belgrade and a full-time planner to New York, as soon as the UN agrees. We will also deploy a U-2 for surveillance along the Adriatic and over Bosnia.

Diplomatic Activity

USNATO will be directed to begin educating allies about our efforts to fix and support the UN plan, our desire to avoid the use of force (lest they get the wrong impression), and possible practical roles for allies and for NATO itself.

We will maintain contact with the UN at various levels, including the SYG, to ensure it is understood that we want to help, that the effectiveness of an operation will require UN-US cooperation, and that joint planning must begin promptly. We will specifically encourage the UN to request the EUCOM team, the planner for NY, and the U-2 product.

We will use NATO to consult with allies. We also will need to use direct channels with key allies: Canada, Italy, France, Germany, and the UK. We are beginning a discussion with the Russians during Secretary Baker's meeting with Foreign Minister Kozyrev in London; the Russians may have specific support to offer (e.g., airlift) but in any case will need to be kept in a politically cooperative frame of mind. The Saudis and other Arabs may be prepared to contribute materially or financially.

Finally, we will consider whether we have specific requests of Milosevic that might facilitate safe and effective operations, bearing in mind that operating out of Belgrade may prove useful and that he might be in a mood to cooperate. We will not, however, offer sanctions relief in return for Serbia's help.

Public Stance

All agencies will draw on and confine themselves to the following points in public discussion:

- The President has made clear that the United States is concerned about the human tragedy in Bosnia.

- The UNSC has stated its insistence that the international community be permitted to bring humanitarian relief to those suffering in Bosnia.
- The US strongly supports the efforts of the UN. We are in contact with UN authorities about how to provide such relief. The cooperation of the parties to the Bosnian conflict will be required to permit such relief to be delivered effectively and safely. The US urges the parties to extend such cooperation.
- The U.S. is offering to help the UN provide humanitarian relief on the assumption that conditions for an effective and safe operation can be created. A number of other countries are already involved.

When asked about military intervention or the use of force, we will all say:

- We expect the parties to cooperate so that this human misery can be relieved in a safe and peaceful way.
- We will not comment on hypothetical questions about how we would react to threats against UN operations or American, allied, or UN personnel.

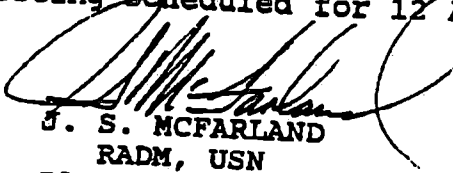

TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER

SUBJECT: Request for National Security Policy Review (U) -
ACTION MEMORANDUM

1. (C) Three current export license applications from U.S. firms for exports of telecommunications equipment to China raise serious export control policy concerns over and above the immediate effect of the exports on the U.S. national security. I believe that approval of these cases and their submission to COCOM would seriously undermine the ability of the United States to continue to maintain export controls on the equipment covered by the applications, not only to China but to Russia and the other COCOM-proscribed countries, at a crucial point in the ongoing discussion of telecommunications controls in COCOM. I therefore request that these cases be put on hold pending consideration of their policy implications by the Policy Coordinating Committee for Technology Transfer, in accordance with NSD 53.

2. (C) Two of the cases, numbers D164450 and D171117, concern the export to China of software using common channel signaling to provide call roaming and handoff in province-wide multi-switch cellular telephone systems in two provinces. Approval of these exports would seriously damage our ability to continue to control exports of inter-city common channel signaling to China. Moreover, approval would greatly increase the difficulties the U.S. will face in the coming months as we resume discussion in COCOM of controls on common channel signaling for Russia et al. The third case, number D163456, concerns the export of a cesium-beam frequency standard, a highly accurate clock standard which would help the Chinese to synchronize their national telecommunications network.

3. (U) Please include consideration of these cases on the agenda of the PCC-TT meeting scheduled for 12 August.

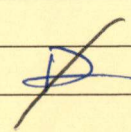

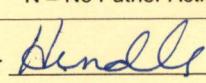

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The following summarizes key conclusions and taskings as a result of the August 13 Small Group Meeting:

- Steps should be taken immediately to enhance current UNHCR/UNPROFOR relief efforts. These include: demanding access to cities under siege to assess conditions, applying diplomatic pressure to gain access/security from factions involved, and establishing a Movement Control Center in Zagreb.
- The working group will also examine the heavy weapons consolidation issue as well as develop follow-on strategies involving international relief organizations and selected allies to followup on the ICRC visits to camps. (NSC)
- On an urgent basis, the effectiveness of the embargo against Serbia should be assessed and appropriate measures taken to tighten the embargo. These include the following issues related to sanctions: Danube monitoring, transshipment, Romanian monitors, Serbian violations of the arms embargo, and possible shipments through the Adriatic. (NSC)
- Participants will provide expeditiously comments to State on the draft paper circulated on the proposal for Romanian monitoring mission.
- The intelligence community will report regularly on progress in establishing conditions in detention (concentration) camps. This should include a summary of alleged camps, verified camps, visited camps, and conditions. (CIA)
- The intelligence community also will develop a priority list of those cities and towns believed to be the sites of the worst hunger/medical conditions or greatest needs. (CIA)
- The working Group will also examine ways we can maximize the London Conference to advance the 'cooperative concept' for delivering humanitarian aid. As a first step, the group will develop a concept of ceasefire that we can promote. (NSC).
- We will send immediate instructions to NATO to follow up on the initial military Committee's report on the contingency use of force. (STATE)
