REQUEST: To hold a NSC meeting on Libya.

PURPOSE: To discuss U.S. policy toward Libya.

BACKGROUND: An NSC meeting is necessary now to consider several issues regarding Libya.

PREVIOUS PARTICIPATION: The President chaired the NSC meeting that reviewed U.S. policy toward Libya; subsequently, he signed NSD 19.

DATE AND TIME: Open, between December 11-15.
DURATION: One hour.

PARTICIPANTS: The President; the Vice President; James Baker, Secretary of State; Richard Cheney, Secretary of Defense; Brent Scowcroft, NSC Advisor; General Colin Powell, Chairman, JCS; Richard Thornburgh, Attorney General; Richard Darman, Director, OMB; William Webster, Director, CIA; Robert Gates, Deputy NSC Advisor.

OUTLINE OF EVENTS: The President opens the meeting, and turns it over to General Scowcroft.
