FROM: BRENT SCOWCROFT 
SUBJECT: Decisions on START and Defense and Space

Purpose

To make certain decisions required for the resumption of negotiations with the Soviet Union on START and Defense and Space.

Background

Our recent NSC meetings have provided the framework upon which to make a series of decisions required to advance our positions at the START and Defense and Space talks which resume on June 19.

The attached decision document summarizes the major issues you should decide. The views of each agency are included.

I also am including for your reference the detailed discussion papers and agency views on all of these and all of the other issues that were reviewed in preparation for the resumption of negotiations.

RECOMMENDATION

That you review the attached decision document (Tab A) and indicate your decisions prior to the resumption of negotiations.
