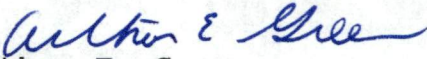

The National Security Review of Low Intensity Conflict (NSR) has been completed and the report formally coordinated with the participating departments and agencies. The report (Tab I) is the result of fourteen months of considerable research, innumerable interviews, and visits to three U.S. embassies and a unified command. The final product represents extensive negotiation and compromise among the departments.

The key finding of the review was the need for enhanced inter-agency coordination under NSC direction. This was supported by the vast majority of those interviewed, to include ambassadors and country teams in the field. While State does not oppose improved coordination, they do not agree with the key recommendations of the study calling for a LIC PCC to look at generic LIC issues and a support mechanism for augmenting country teams in need of assistance under regional PCC supervision. I suspect that the proposal for NSC chairmanship of the PCC is at the heart of State's nonconcurrence. However, the other departments have been adamant on the need for NSC leadership of this committee.

In this context, the LIC Working Group is prepared to present the results to the Deputies Committee in its role as the LIC Board in order to act upon the recommendations. Further debate below the Deputies at this point in the review effort will produce few returns. Furthermore, there is growing anticipation outside of the Executive branch, both within the Congress and the private sector, for NSC movement on LIC related problems.

RECOMMENDATION

That you agree to convene a Deputies Committee to consider the recommendations resulting from the NSR.
