SUBJECT: Secure Telephones, STU-III

National policy set forth in various Presidential directives requires that communication of all classified and unclassified/sensitive information, both voice and data, be protected. In accordance with these directives, the White House Communications Agency (WHCA) is installing a new type of secure telephone, the STU-III, in support of various White House requirements.

Offices that routinely deal with classified information or national security matters have long been provided with secure telephones, referred to as "RED phones". RED phone installations are complex and too costly for offices that are not routinely involved in national security issues. STU-III's provide a simpler and less costly means of providing required protection. The STU-III has become the standard secure telephone, government-wide, replacing most older systems, and augmenting the existing RED telephone networks. WHCA is providing interfaces which enable STU-III users to talk to RED telephone users. Cellular STU-III telephones will also replace the cellular telephones now installed in all White House Garage vehicles.

Public Law 100-235, January 8, 1988, The Computer Security Act of 1987, defines 'sensitive information' as "any information, the loss, misuse or unauthorized access to or modification of which could adversely affect the national interest or the conduct of Federal programs, or the privacy to which individuals are entitled under section 552a of title 5, United States Code (the Privacy Act), but which has not been specifically authorized under the criteria established by an Executive order or an Act of Congress to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy; and ..."

The Department of Defense, as executive agent for implementation of the President's secure communications directives, has expanded

the Public Law definition of sensitive information so as to include all information which relates to operations, plans, system acquisition, resource allocation, logistics support and personnel management. Additionally, communications between the government and contractors, including information incident to the performance of contracts involving technologies listed in the current edition of the Military Critical Technologies List, should also be protected from unauthorized access.

The U.S. Secret Service also considers sensitive information to include information pertaining to the security of protectees, i.e., the President and Vice President, and their movements, schedules, locations, and the physical and technical security afforded to them.

Please review your office's communications requirements and determine whether or not your office has a need to communicate classified or unclassified/sensitive information and provide a point of contact to this office by July 14, 1989. This office will then arrange a meeting to address specific concerns and develop initial requirements.

The results of this effort will be used to determine the type of security required and the best means with which to satisfy the need. It is not our intent to put a STU-III on every desk throughout the EOP but we do intend that every office that has a need to communicate classified or unclassified/sensitive information will be provided with access to a secure telephone.

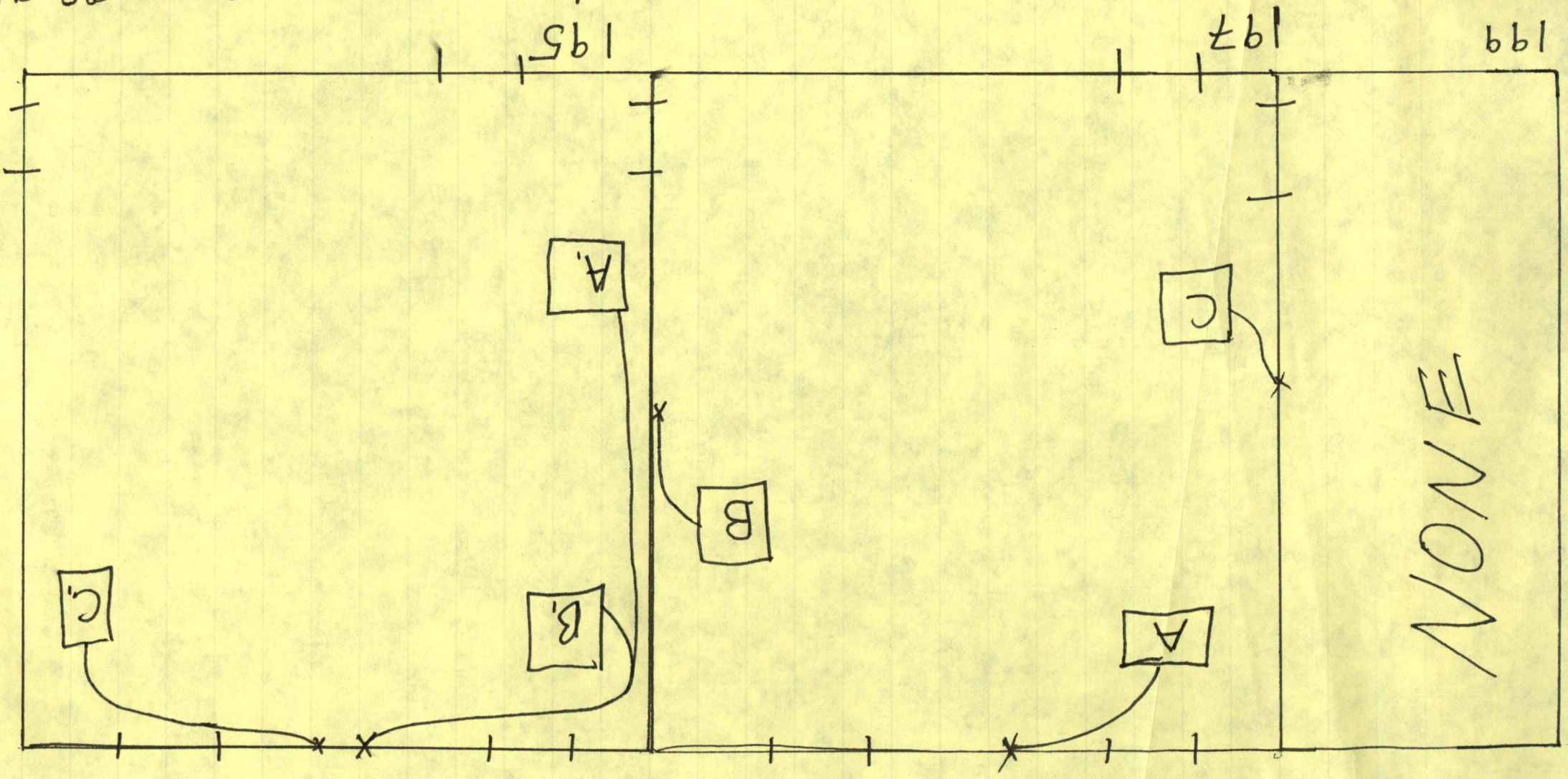
