Thank you, Olivia. ((You know, Barbara and I don't often see this many stars together all at once. Finally -- somebody understood what I meant by a "thousand points of light"...))

Barbara and I have been thrilled by tonight's program -- the musical inspiration, the wonder, the excitement. It has given our holidays a magnificent beginning.

For all of the kids and the families that are here; for the Bush family; and for many watching across the country, this will be a very special Christmas.

It is a time when we think about giving more of ourselves. We understand that the value of our lives is not measured by our possessions, but by the good we do for others. Each of us can be a point of light in someone's life -- making this holiday season a little brighter for those in need.

Christmas is always a time for reaching across the table, joining hands, and raising voices. It is a time to celebrate the birth of God's love on earth.

But this year, Christmas has a powerful new meaning. For people around the world, Christmas in 1989 will be a moment to be remembered. A moment of new faith in freedom. New hope for peace.

Since the end of World War II, the world has waited. For

forty years the world has known only a grim and joyless peace -- as hard and cold as a long winter night.

But now, everywhere, we see signs of a warmer, more hopeful peace, like a candle that flickers in a distant window. It beckons, encourages, casts a bright glow in the world's darkest corners.

Change comes, and challenges us. Freedom comes, and lights a candle that can never be put out.

Voices are raised -- some in songs of joy, some in cries for freedom -- but all are heard on God's earth. We speak of a "peace the world cannot give" -- but we know God can give us the strength to find it.

In corners still shrouded in oppression and darkness, the yearning for freedom still burns brightly within. May all who dare to hope for it, find it.

Let every candle we light, every hand we offer, symbolize the hope of a new century, the hope of mankind: That there **will** be peace on earth -- good will -- and the blessings of freedom, for **all** the peoples of the world.
