WILSON SPEECH

ARTICLES

N.R. ARTICLE, 8/13/90: ANALYSIS

1) WHY THIS RACE IS OF TANTAMOUNT IMPORTANCE FOR DEMS AND REPUBS ALIKE.

"AFTER THE REAPPORTIONMENT OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES BASED ON THE '90 CENSUS, THE CALIFORNIA DELEGATION WILL CONSTITUTE ONE-EIGHTH OF THE CONGRESS. IF A REPUBLICAN DOES NOT PRESIDE AS GOVERNOR IN A STATE WHERE THE DEMOCRATS CONTROL THE LEGISLATURE THE GOP WILL PLAY ALMOST NO ROLE IN THE REDISTRICTING. AT THE SAME TIME, THERE CAN BE NO REALISTIC PLAN BY ANY PRESIDENTIAL NOMINEE OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY TO WIN THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE WITHOUT FIGURING IN CALIFORNIA."

AGAIN, ALTHOUGH YOU MIGHT WANT TO TOUCH UPON THE LARGER IMPORTANCE OF THIS RACE FOR REPUBS NATIONWIDE, THEREBY PERHAPS BOTH MOTIVATING SOME APATHETIC VOTERS AND ALSO QUIETING/WINNING OVER CRITICS TO THE RIGHT; THERE IS ALSO WHAT I BELIEVE TO BE THE REAL DANGER OF REINFORCING THE IMAG OF WILSON AS REPUBLICAN TOOL, OR WILSON AS A MAN MOVED ONLY BY POLITICAL MOTIVES. NOTE: "IN FEINSTEIN CAMPAIGN RESEARCH, WILSON APPEARS AS TOO POLITICALLY M^OTIVATED. FOUR FOCUS GROUPS IN HEAVILY REPUBLICAN ORANGE COUNTY HAD DIFFICULTY ASSIGNING A RATIONALE TO HIM BESIDES AMBITION."

2) ON APPROACHING THE ENVIRONMENT ISSUE--IT SEEMS THAT DIFI WILL INEVITABLY BE SEEN AS THE MORE PRO-ENVIRONMENT CANDIDATE. N.R. TALKS ABOUT THE POPULARITY OF HER DECISION TO STAND BY THE BIG GREEN ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVE; WILSON HAS DENOUNCED THAT INITIATIVE. I DON'T KNOW MUCH POLITICAL FANFARE WE CAN SQUEEZE OUT OF TRUMPETING HIS MODERATE POSITION IT DOESN'T EXACTLY SEEM THE MOST INSPIRATIONAL. IT MIGHT BE A LOSING BATTLE, THERE ARE OTHER AREAS WHERE SHE IS MORE VULNERABLE, AND HE CLEARLY STRONGER.

3) N.R. MAKES THE ARGUMENT THAT WHILE WILSON IS PERCEIVED AS LACKLUSTER, A LOT OF DIFI'S APPEAL RESTS IN PERSONALITY, PANACHE, AND PERSONAL HISTORY:

"HER PERSONAL SAGA IS HER GREATEST POLITICAL ASSET, TRANSCENDING HER POSITION ON THIS OR THAT ISSUE....THE LAST THING CALIFORNIANS WANT IS LOW-KEY REALITY..."

- 2) NOV. 6, 1869 MARKED THE FIRST COLLEGE FOOTBALL GAME EVER PLAYED.
SO MAYBE: "THE COMING ELECTION DAY, NOV. 6TH, WILL MARK THE 121ST ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST COLLEGE FOOTBALL GAME EVER PLAYED. ON THAT DAY, ONE TEAM WON, ONE LOST. WILSON SPEECH

PRES: "THE SITUATION IN THE GULF BRINGS TO MIND AN OLD SEAFARING TALE, ONE NIGHT AT SEA, THE CAPTAIN OF A PIRATE SHIP SAW WHAT LOOKED LIKE THE LIGHTS OF ANOTHER SHIP HEADING TOWARD HIM. HE HAD HIS SIGNALMAN BLINK TO THE OTHER SHIP: 'CHANGE YOUR COURSE 10 DEGREES SOUTH.' THE REPLY CAME BACK: 'CHANGE YOUR COURSE 10 DEGREES NORTH.' ....AMERICA TOO HAS BEEN A BEACON, A BEACON FOUNDED ON ROCK...DETECTING Agression WITH THE CERTAINTY THAT AN EVIL COURSE WILL COME TO RUIN, AND LIGHTING THE WAY OF FREEDOM AND JUSTICE FOR ALL THOSE WHO WISH TO FOLLOW.

SHELBY DESCRIBES HER SON: "ROB IS 6'4" IN HIS UNIFORM, HE LOOKS LIKE A POSTER PICTURE OF A U.S. MARINE." SHELBY DESCRIBES HERSELF AS A "PROFESSIONAL MOM." SAYING, "I STAND PROUD IN THAT POSITION."

SHELBY AND HAROLD DEW ARE ASKING THREE THINGS OF THEIR FRIENDS, 1) PRAY, 2) FLY YOUR FLAG, AND 3) VOTE TO BRING RESPONSIBLY PEOPLE TO LEAD OUR COUNTY AND OUR COUNTRY. (THE MIDDLEBURG PRESS, AUG 16 ,90)

SHELBY EXPRESSES HER LOVE FOR THE FLAG, AND HER CHAGRIN AT SEEING IT BURNED IN THE MIDDLE EAST IN A POEM, "AMERICA BURNING," A FEW LINES OF WHICH GO...

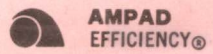

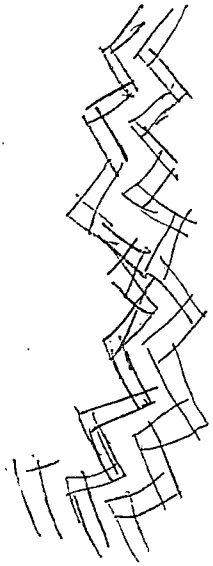
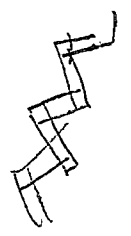

→ Thanks, George [Deukmejian] -- it's great to be back in California for such a good cause -- helping out the man who's going to be your successor. And what a great act to follow. \\

You know, when they talked to me about this fundraiser, they told me they were calling because, they said, "it would be a big boost if our party's number one asset came here to help out." I said, "fine. What time do you want Barbara to be there?" \\

Looking around, I see lots of reasons why the California GOP is going to be so strong in November: the rest of your ticket -- Marian [Bergeson] for Lieutenant Governor; Joan [Milke Flores], for Secretary of State; and Matt [Fong], for Controller. And a special thanks to Frank [Fisco, State Chair]; Katie [Boyd], Gene [Trefethen] and Ben [Biaggini], who have done such a great job at pulling this event together -- twice. \\

Change your course south -- I am in a pirate ship." To which the reply came back: "Change your course north -- I am in a lighthouse." \\\

America and her partners are that beacon on a rock-strong foundation, lighting the way through the darkness. \\\

We must not think about the Persian Gulf without remembering our young men and women who are there, ready to stand firm in the desert sands against this threat to our world.

People like 18-year-old Michael Pigeon, who wanted to join the Marines here in California in order to serve his country in the Gulf. The corps wouldn't issue him an airline ticket because he was 20 pounds overweight. So he walked 2,500 miles from Detroit to reach his dream -- and his goal. Not only did he make it to camp, but he lost the weight. And he says now that marching in combat boots will be no problem for him now. \\\ Gives a new meaning to "I'd walk a mile for a camel." \\\

And soldiers like Corporal Robert Dew, who was born and grew up here. His mother wrote him a farewell letter as he packed for Saudi Arabia, where he will be serving in ground support maintenance. She told him: "God has given me the strength to say good-bye for a while for you to serve your country. Now all I can do is ask God to hold you in his loving arms and protect you as I used to." \\\

I want to echo that prayer of Corporal Dew's mother, and I want to ask all of you -- all Americans -- to do the same. Pray that the young men and women of our country, and the others at their side, will be protected and will return strong and safe to a nation proud of its values of freedom and its tradition of serving and protecting others. \\\

God bless them, and God bless America.
