AMERICAN STUDENTS
PRISON AT OLD CASTLE HILL**

1969 JUL 15 AM 5:00

- 0 IT IS MOVING FOR ME TO MEET WITH YOU AT THE SITE WHERE ONE OF HUNGARY'S GREATEST FREEDOM FIGHTERS, LAJOS KOSSUTH ((LA-YOSH KO-SHOOT)) WAS IMPRISONED FOR HAVING DEFENDED HIS IDEALS. HE ALSO TAUGHT HIMSELF ENGLISH HERE.

FOR AMERICANS, HE IS AN EXAMPLE OF DEDICATION AND HEROIC SELFLESSNESS IN THE QUEST FOR FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY.

- 0 THIS IS ANOTHER HISTORIC PERIOD FOR HUNGARY AND FOR EAST CENTRAL EUROPE, AS CHANGES IN POLITICAL INSTITUTIONS AND ECONOMIES ARE SWEEPING MANY NATIONS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

- 0 YOU, AS YOUNG PEOPLE, HAVE AN IMPORTANT ROLE TO PLAY IN THE FUTURE, YOUR OWN AND YOUR COUNTRY'S.
- 0 EDUCATION IS THE KEY -- TO ECONOMIC GROWTH, POLITICAL FREEDOM, AND PERSONAL DIRECTION. MOST OF ALL, IT PROVIDES OPPORTUNITY. ACADEMIC EXCHANGE PROGRAMS WHICH MY ADMINISTRATION STRONGLY SUPPORTS, ARE A GOOD EXAMPLE, AND WE HOPE TO HAVE MORE OF THEM SOON.

- 0 IT IS GRATIFYING TO SEE YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN ACTIVELY INTERESTED IN THE AFFAIRS OF THEIR COUNTRY -- ESPECIALLY THOSE OF YOU INVOLVED IN ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS FIDESZ ((FEE-DESS)) [THE MOST DEMOCRATIC YOUTH GROUP] AND OTHERS LIKE IT.
- 0 I'D LIKE TO HEAR YOUR VIEWS ON CURRENT EVENTS:
-- WHAT DO YOU FEEL ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT PROBLEMS TO BE RESOLVED IN YOUR COUNTRY?
