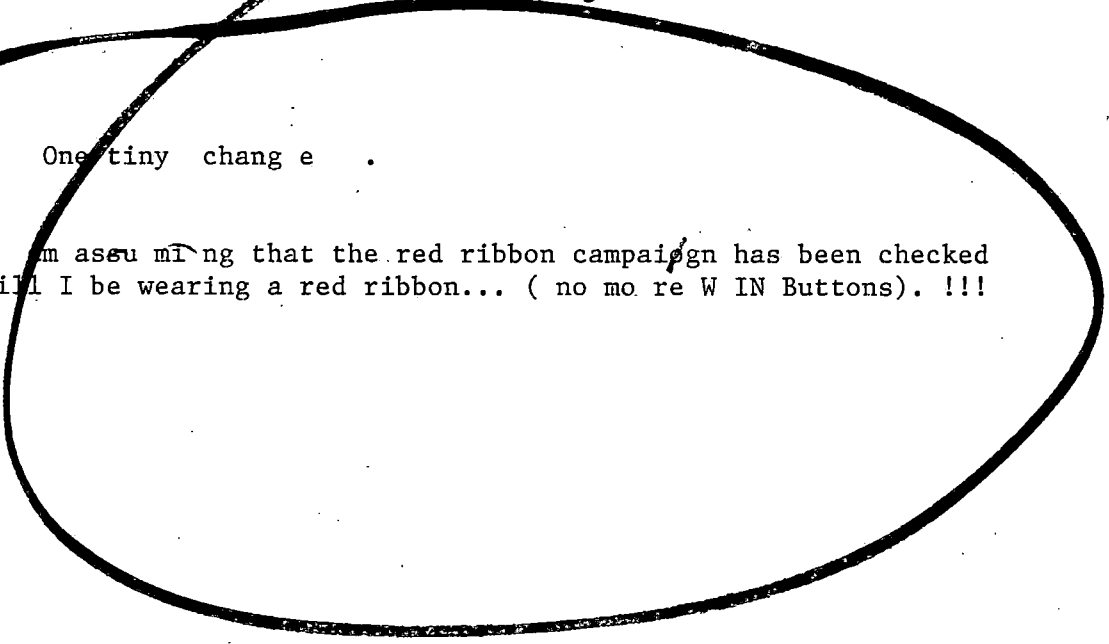

While the federal government can, and will, set strong environmental performance standards, America needs your unique problem-solving talents -- and your leadership -- to help protect the environment while also protecting the economy. And while some say that sound ecology and a strong economy are mutually exclusive -- I say they ^{can not} must go hand-in-hand.

We can mark the 1990s as the decade when business leaders worked in earnest with such notable groups as the Environmental Defense Fund.

We can reverse the errors of this generation, mindful of the next. All of us have been given a trust, a trust that lies in the stewardship of our planet. In this, we must not fail.
