SUBJECT: REMARKS FOR THE VERMONT GOP BREAKFAST

I. SUMMARY

On Friday, October 5, 1990 you will make remarks at a breakfast for the Vermont Republican Party. The event will be held at the Sheraton Hotel in Burlington, Vermont; 475 guests are expected. Your remarks are twelve minutes in length and will be TelePrompted.

II. DISCUSSION

This fundraising event will focus on Vermont's current Republican candidates, namely Congressman Peter Smith (running for re-election), Dick Snelling (gubernatorial candidate), and Mike Bernhardt (running for Lt. Governor). The attached remarks applaud their experience and the leadership they will bring to office.

Your remarks stress the positive points of the recent budget agreement, particularly with regard to the domestic economy.

You also stress the resolve of the U.S. to face down aggression in the Persian Gulf, and note the commitment of our servicemen and women.

Finally, you highlight some of the support projects for our troops currently underway in this country. Bernard and Joanna Campbell, the parents whose son you quote, will be in the audience.
