GOOD EVENING. IT'S A PLEASURE TO BE WITH YOU AS YOU REFLECT ON OUR INVOLVEMENT IN WORLD WAR II NEARLY FIFTY YEARS AGO.

AS YOU KNOW, IN THE LAST HALF CENTURY, OUR NAVY HAS CHANGED DRAMATICALLY, INCREASING OUR ABILITY TO KEEP THE SEA LANES FREE, HELPING US TO MAINTAIN PEACE, AND RESPONDING WITH PATRIOTISM AND PROFESSIONALISM IN TIMES OF CRISIS.
